Call to Order and Roll Call

The Combined Bill Audit and Road and Bridge District Meeting of the Township Board was called to order by **Supervisor Schumann** in the Township Hall, 10802 S. Roberts Road, Palos Hills, Illinois at 6:34 P.M. Roll call was taken by the **Clerk** of the Township, **Jane Nolan.** Present were Trustees Brannigan, Riley and Woods, Supervisor Schumann and Highway Commissioner Adams. Also present was Township Attorney **Erik Peck** and Road and Bridge Administrative Assistant, **April Schrader**.

Pledge of Allegiance

Supervisor Schumann led the assembly in the Pledge of Allegiance.

Disposition of Minutes from Previous Meeting

a. Approval of the Minutes of the Combined Bill Audit and Road and Bridge District Meeting – September 23, 2019

Trustee Woods moved to approve the minutes of the September 23, 2019, Combined Bill Audit and Road and Bridge District Meeting. **Trustee Riley** seconded the motion. Roll call was taken. Ayes: Trustees Brannigan, Riley and Woods, Supervisor Schumann. Nays: None. Motion carried 4-0.

Special Presentations-Communications

There were no special presentations or communications at this meeting.

Reports of Officials

a. Supervisor Schumann

1. Authorization to Hire a New Health Service Employee

Supervisor Schumann reported that the new part-time employee at the Health Service is not an addition, she is a replacement.

Supervisor Schumann moved to authorize the employment of Elise Farrell R.N. as a nurse in the Health Service. **Trustee Woods** seconded the motion. Roll call was taken. Ayes: Trustee Brannigan, Riley and Woods, Supervisor Schumann. The motion was carried unanimously.

Clerk Nolan explained that this annual conference is very informative and is a perfect chance to meet and get to know other officials and obtain information about their respective townships. 2. Highway Commissioner

Highway Commissioner Adams reported that he had an eventful weekend with all of the rain. He restated that Lindhal Bros Inc has received the contract for the paving for six to nine township roads depending on the time limit. They are on schedule to complete these roads before the season ends (the middle of November.)

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE LEVYING AND ASSESSMENT OF TAXES FOR THE TOWN OF PALOS, COOK COUNTY, ILLINOIS, FOR THE FISCAL YEAR COMMENCING ON APRIL 1, 2019 AND ENDING MARCH 31, 2020

BE IT ORDAINED by the PALOS TOWNSHIP BOARD, Cook County, Illinois as follows:

SECTION 1 - INCORPORATION

Heretofore, an ordinance entitled "BUDGET AND APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE FOR PALOS TOWNSHIP, COOK COUNTY, ILLINOIS, FOR THE FISCAL YEAR COMMENCING APRIL 1, 2019 AND ENDING MARCH 31, 2020 was duly passed and published according to law, there having been appropriated for the fiscal year beginning April 1, 2019 and ending March 31, 2020 the sum of ONE MILLION FORTY-ONE THOUSAND THREE HUNDRED SIXTY DOLLARS (\$1,041,360) for the General Town Fund and ONE HUNDRED EIGHTEEN THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED FIFTY EIGHT DOLLARS (\$118,958) for the General Assistance Fund for total appropriations for said fiscal year in the sum of ONE MILLION ONE HUNDRED SIXTY THOUSAND THREE HUNDRED EIGHTEEN DOLLARS (\$1,160,318) for the objects and purposes as set forth therein. Said Budget and Appropriation Ordinance as adopted on June 24, 2019 is incorporated herein by this reference.

SECTION 2 - TAX LEVY AMOUNT

The PALOS TOWNSHIP BOARD, in accordance with the statutes in such case made and provided, has duly ascertained and hereby fixes and determines the total amount of appropriations for all corporate purposes legally made and to be collected from the tax levy for the current fiscal year to be the sum of \$965,800 for the Town Fund and \$136,000 for the General Assistance Fund, respectively, for a total levy in the sum of \$1,101,800.

SECTION 3 – TAX LEVY SUMMARY

Town Fund Tax \$ 965,800

General Assistance Fund Tax \$ 136,000

TOTAL TAXES LEVIED \$1,101,800

SECTION 4 – FILING

The Township Clerk shall make and file a certified copy of this ordinance with the County Clerk of Cook County, Illinois, on or before the last Tuesday of December 2017.

SECTION 5 - SEVERABILITY

If any section, subdivision, or sentence of this ordinance shall for any reason be held invalid or to be unconstitutional, such finding shall not affect the validity of the remaining portion of this ordinance.

SECTION 6 – EFFECTIVE DATE

This ordinance shall be in full force and effect after its adoption as provided by law.

ANNUAL TAX LEVY FOR GENERAL ROAD PURPOSES – 2019

AND OF A SPECIAL TAX PURSUANT TO

SECTION 6-601 (605 ILCS 5/6-601, ET SEQ.) OF THE HIGHWAY CODE

In pursuance of authority vested in him by Sections 6-201.1 and 6-201.5 of the Illinois Highway Code, approved June 8, 1959, as amended, the Highway Commissioner of the Palos Township Road District, Cook County, Illinois, at the office of the Town on November 25th, 2019 did determine that the amount of money necessary to be raised by taxation for road purposes by the General Road Fund tax levy of said Road District for the year 2019 is as hereinafter set forth.

Further, in pursuance of authority vested in them by Section 6-601, *et seq.* of the Illinois Highway Code, approved July 8, 1959, as amended, the electors of Palos Township Road District, Cook County, Illinois, at a Special Town Meeting held December 13, 2001, authorized Palos Township Road District to levy an annual tax of 0.22% for the purpose of construction and maintaining gravel, rock, macadam and other hard roads (Special Hard Road Tax), and the Township Board of Trustees did, within the time required by law, certify such tax to the Clerk of Cook County and caused a copy of such certification to be filed in the office of the District Clerk all as required by Sections 6-602 and 6-605 of the Illinois Highway Code.

PART I

GENERAL ROAD FUND LEVY

General Road Fund, THREE HUNDRED SIX THOUSAND NINE-HUNDRED (\$306,900), needed for the several uses and purposes as follows, to-wit:

Making the amount to be raised by taxation and levied on all taxable property of said District for the uses and purposes aforesaid, for the General Road Fund, the sum THREE HUNDRED NINETEEN THOUSAND NINE-HUNDRED EIGHTY- FIVE (\$306,900).

It is hereby directed that said sum, if approved by the County Board of Cook County, or such part thereof as the said County Board shall approve, be and the same is hereby levied as General Road Tax against all the taxable property of said District for the year 2019.

PART II

SPECIAL TAX PURSUANT TO SECTION 6-601 OF THE HIGHWAY CODE

Pursuant to vote of the Electors of Palos Township Road District on December 13, 2001, and duly certified to the Clerk of Cook County, Illinois, all in accordance with Chapter 605, Section 5/6-601 of the Illinois Compiled Statutes (Section 6-601 of the Illinois Highway Code), a special tax for the purpose of constructing and maintaining gravel, rock, macadam or other hard roads, sometimes known as a Special Hard Road Tax shall be levied and extended by the Cook County Clerk on the taxable property of the Road District as equalized or assessed by the Department of Revenue.

It is hereby directed that the Clerk of Cook County, Illinois, shall cause such special tax levy as hereby certified to be extended on the tax books for the current year 2019 in the sum of FOUR HUNDRED SIXTY THREE THOUSAND ONE HUNDRED (\$463,100), all as required by Section 6-602 (605 ILCS 5/6-602) of the Highway Code.
