# a. Supervisor

#### 1. Discussion of Commonwealth Edison

**Supervisor Schumann** stated that ComEd will retro fit LED lights for the township if Palos Township applies for this service. There is a fee but

there are large rebates available. There will be more information forthcoming concerning this.

### 1. Township Day

# 1. Audit and Approve of Town Fund Bills and Warrants

# b. Policy and Personnel - Supervisor Schumann

**Supervisor Schumann** reported that there was a large "Souper Bowl" food delivery to the Township Food Pantry in February. Only Palos West Elementary School took part in "Souper Bowl" this year. Palos West School will receive a beautiful glass apple with an engraved "thank you" from Palos Township to show our appreciation for all they did for our residents.

# c. Technology, Information and Automation – Trustee Riley

**Trustee Riley** stated that the internet speed at the township has been doubled. If there are any problems the modem speed on a computer can be checked.

**Trustee Woods** discussed a new server for the township. He has been looking at several new servers. The township would also need a server closet. The server would be able to digitize all the township records. It would resemble a regular computer and would make FOIA requests easier to work with and complete. The cost would fall between \$1,500.00 and \$3,000.00. He stated that \$3,000.00 has been placed in the budget for this expense.
