Roll call was taken by the Clerk of the Township, **Jane Nolan.** Present were Trustees Brannigan, Jeanes, and Woods. Supervisor Schumann. Also present was Township Attorney, Erik Peck.

Pledge of Allegiance

Supervisor Schumann led the assembly in the Pledge of Allegiance.

Approval of Prior Meeting's Minutes

a. Approval of Minutes – General Meeting August 13, 2018

Trustee Woods moved to approve the minutes of the August 13, 2018, General Meeting. **Trustee Brannigan** seconded the motion. Roll call was taken. Ayes: Trustees Brannigan, Jeanes, and Woods, Supervisor Schumann. Nays: None. Motion carried 5-0.

The meeting was recessed at 7:05 P.M. due to the loud screaming and chanting of the audience which were over 95% protestors. As soon as the meeting began one protestor began loudly reading a letter and would not stop. They were told three times to keep quiet to allow our government meeting to progress, but they would not, so Supervisor Schumann called for a recess.

The meeting was reconvened at 7:16, but nothing had changed. The screaming and chanting continued.

Special Presentations/Communications

There were no special presentations or communications at this meeting.

Reports of Officials

a. Supervisor/Treasurer

Supervisor Schumann reiterated, once again, that the Palos Park Parade is Saturday, September 15, 2018, at 11:00 A.M.

b. Clerk

1. Unincorporated Sticker Update

Clerk Nolan reported that the Township has collected over \$60,00 in payments for stickers for unincorporated Palos Township. This money is sent to Cook County.

2. TOCC/MTA September 8, 2018 Summer Symposium

Clerk Nolan did not attempt to give this report as the screaming and chanting would not allow it.

Attorney's Report

Attorney Peck stated that he did not have a report for the Board.

Reports of Standing Committees

a. Finance and Administration- Trustee Woods

Trustee Woods reported that he and **Trustee Riley** are working on a computer screen for the township and are also developing a u-tube channel for the township.

Disposition of Minutes from Previous Meeting's

Special Presentations/Communications

Trustee Nick Bobis, **Rich Township**, spoke to the Board concerning the **TOCC Trustee Division**. He is interested in the Palos Township Trustees becoming more involved in the TOCC Trustee Division. He gave excellent examples of the work the

division does each year. He would like one of the trustees to become the Trustee Ambassador from Palos Township, a position which **Clerk Nolan** is now occupying. He made a very interesting and compelling presentation. The next meeting of the **TOCC Trustee Division** is October 18, 2018, at Mama Luigl's in Bridgeview, Illinois, at 6:30 P.M.

Reports of Officials

a. Supervisor

1. Senate Bill 2923

Supervisor Schumann reported that Senate Bill 2923 states that beginning January 1, 2019, all Township Clerks must attest with their signature all the checks for township business incurred. There are rules to be followed concerning this bill. A discussion of this bill ensued.

b. Clerk

1. Township Communications Group

Clerk Nolan stated that the group is presently composed of 16 Townships which work together on various topics such as social media, newsletters, media releases, brochures, flyers, community outreach and more. These encompass the world of communications and marketing. It has adopted an organizational name of Township Communications of Illinois, and appointed officers to assist in promoting the group, preparing meeting topics and sharing information with the membership. The meetings are at 12 Noon once a month in varying townships.

2. Notes from the Summer Symposium - September 8, 2018

Clerk Nolan discussed the Summer Symposium that she attended on September 8, 2018, in Hanover Township. She attended the Food

Pantry Best Practices, and Employment Law sessions in addition to the opening and closing speaker sessions. **Clerk Nolan** thought it was a very informative symposium with all the sessions interesting and timely.

c. Highway Commissioner

Highway Commissioner Adams stated that the Road District has completed all the pot hole work at this time. Many permits have recently been issues by the Highway Department.

Attorney Peck stated that he had no report for the Board.

Finance and Administration – Trustee Woods

1. Audit and Approval of Town Fund Vouchers and Warrants – October 2018

Trustee Woods moved to approve the audit of the Town Fund Warrants and Bills in the amount of \$219.52 for the month of September, and \$10,683.64 for the month of October. **Trustee Riley** seconded the motion. d. Building and Grounds – Trustee Jeanes

The winning bid will be awarded after Morris Engineering has checked that all the facts and statistics are correct. There may be a need to close the township for a day due to this project. RESOLUTION 2018-R-

A RESOLUTION REQUIRING TOWNSHIP CLERK TO "ATTEST" THE SIGNATURES OF TOWNSHIP SUPERVISOR ON ALL PAYOUTS

WHEREAS, Palos Township, Cook County, Illinois is a non-home rule unit of local government pursuant to Article VII, § 8 of the 1970 Illinois Constitution; and

WHEREAS, On August 19, 2018, Governor Rauner signed Senate Bill 2923 into law (now Public Act 100- 0983) starting on January 1, 2019; and

WHEREAS, this new law requires the Township Clerk to "attest" the signature of the Township Supervisor on all payouts from the Township and Road District treasury (including payments for cemetery purposes); and

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees has determined that it must comply with the Act by passage of this resolution.

NOW THEREFORE, THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF PALOS TOWNSHIP, COOK COUNTY, ILLINOIS, RESOLVE THAT THE FOLLOWING RESOLUTION TO REQUIRES THE TOWNSHIP CLERK TO "ATTEST" THE SIGNATURE OF THE TOWNSHIP SUPERVISOR ON ALL PAYOUTS BE AND HEREBY IS ADOPTED AS FOLLOWS:

Pursuant to Public Act 100-0983 and commencing on January 1, 2019, the Palos Township Clerk shall "attest" the signatures of the Supervisor on all payouts from the Township and Road District treasury (including payments for cemetery purposes). The Township will conform to and comply with all requirements set forth in Public Act 100-0983.

Attesting a document means the Township Clerk will witness or formally certify content by signing his or her name.

SECTION XII: Effective Date. This Resolution shall be in full force and eff	ect from and after its passage.
