6. Reports of Officials

a. Supervisor

Supervisor Schumann stated that everything is going well at this time. She reported that she and **Assessor Maloney** co-sponsored

a Tax Appeal Outreach in Palos Park on August 25th, 2015, and they will also be co-sponsoring a Tax Appeal Outreach here in Palos Township on September 1, 2015.

b. Clerk

1. Unincorporated Vehicle Sticker Update

Clerk Nolan reported to the Board that Palos Township has collected \$52,795 to date from the unincorporated area sticker sales. The number is lower than last year due to the fact that more residents are doing this on-line. **Clerk Nolan** also reported that a second letter has been sent to residents who have not yet purchased their stickers from the Department of Revenue.

There was a Board discussion of this topic.

Trustee Riley moved to approve a 3% salary increase for the employees of the Township less the doctors and the two RN hires in the Health Service retroactive beginning April 1, 2015, and ending in fiscal year 2016. **Trustee Woods** seconded the motion. Roll call was taken. Ayes: Trustees Jeanes, Riley and Woods, Supervisor Schumann. Nays: None. Motion carried 4-0.

c. Technology, Information and Automation - Trustee Riley

Trustee Riley stated that he had no report.

d. Buildings and Grounds - Trustee Jeanes

Trustee Jeanes stated that he had no report.

e. Public Services and Health - Trustee Brannigan

Due to the absence of **Trustee Brannigan** there was no formal report.

Trustee Woods did report that the Health Service was very busy this month due to school physicals, and he reported that the Health Service had over \$5,000.00 in receipts this month.

ORDINANCE 2015- ___ -O

ORDINANCE OF PALOS TOWNSHIP GENERAL REQUIREMENTS FOR TOWNSHIP BOARD MEETINGS

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PALOS TOWNSHIP BOARD, PALOS TOWNSHIP, ILLINOIS:

SECTION 1: That, Section 2-3-6 of Chapter 3 of Title 2 of the Palos Township Code is amended hereby in its entirety; and shall be and read as follows:

2-3-6 MEETINGS OF THE BOARD.

- A. All meetings of the township board, of any standing or special committee of the board, and of any other board, committee, or agency of the Township shall be open to the public, except when the Board is authorized to close proceedings under any of the provisions of 5 ILCS 120, as amended from time to time.
- B. Meetings shall be held as follows:
 - General Meetings: General meetings of the township board shall be held at the township hall on the second Thursday of each month at six-thirty o'clock (6:30)
 P.M. If the general meeting day falls on a township recognized holiday, on which the township hall is closed, the meeting shall be held on a day that is set by the township board.
 - 2. Bill Audit Meetings: Bill audit meetings of the township board shall be held at the township hall on the fourth Thursday of each month at six-thirty o'clock (6:30) P.M. If the bill audit meeting day falls on a township recognized holiday, on which the township hall is closed, the meeting shall be held on a day that is set by the township board.
 - 3. Road and Bridge Meetings: Road and bridge meetings of the township board shall be held at the township hall on the fourth Thursday of each month at seven o'clock (7:00) P.M. If the road and bridge meeting day falls on a township recognized holiday, on which the township hall is closed, the meeting shall be held on a day that is set by the township board.
 - 4. Special Meetings: Special meetings of the township board may be called by the Supervisor or any two (2) Trustees. The call shall be in writing, include an agenda and shall be delivered to the Township Clerk's office. The Township Clerk shall post the notice and shall effectuate actual or constructive notice of the special meeting to the Township Board and news media by an appropriate method.

C. The agenda for each meeting of the township board shall be prepared by the Township Clerk.

D. RULES AND PROCEDURES FOR MEETINGS:

1. Adoption Of Robert's Rules of Order Newly Revised: The Township Board hereby adopts "Robert's Rules Of Order Newly Revised", 11th edition, as its rules and procedures and to govern the conduct of all meetings of the township board and committees thereof. Notwithstanding the foregoing, the more specific rules contained in the remaining subsections of this section shall govern where applicable. In all cases where the rules set forth below in the remaining subsections of this section are in conflict with the aforesaid "Robert's Rules of Order Newly Revised", the rules contained in the remaining subsections of this section shall govern and control.

2. Order Of Business:

- A. The agenda at regular meetings of the Township Board shall be substantially as follows:
 - 1. Call to Order
 - 2. Roll Call
 - 3. Pledge of Allegiance
 - 4. Approval of Prior Meeting's Minutes
 - 5. Communications from the Public
 - (a) All board meeting, as well as the meetings of all committees, commissions or other public bodies of the township, shall allow for an agenda item titled "Communications from the Public" during every public meeting. During the Communications from the Public portion of a meeting, any persons who wish to the address the public body on any matter of public business, whether a specific agenda item or not, may request recognition prior to the meeting or during Communications from the Public.
 - (b) During Communications from the Public each person who wishes to address the public body shall have no more than three (3) minutes to do so after they have been recognized by the chairperson. No person shall speak more than one time during a meeting.
 - (c) All persons addressing the public body shall maintain decorum and refrain from personal attacks of others. Questions /or comments shall be limited to public business. Comments supporting or opposing a person's candidacy for elected office are precluded.

(d) Any member of the township board may request information from a speaker after a speaker has concluded his or her comments or after the three (3) minute time period has lapsed; however, a speaker shall not be required to provide any such information as a condition for speaking during Communications from the Public. Any failure to adhere to the provisions of this section, and any such restriction or limitation upon any speaker, shall not impair or affect any ordinance, resolution, motion or other action of the township board.

(e) Public Hearing.

- (1) Public Hearings are not governed by the same rules regarding public comment as public meetings.
- (2) Except as determined by the chairperson of the public body that published the notice for the Public Hearing, no person shall be permitted to address the public body during a Public Hearing.
- (3) During a Public Hearing, the chairperson may require testimony be provided in accordance with requirements of a Public Hearing and may limit comments to those matters relevant to the subject set forth in the notice of Public Hearing and any other manner necessary to accomplish the purpose of said Public Hearing. Persons wishing to avail themselves of the opportunity to speak and/or testify at a Public Hearing may be required to state his or her name and address and swear to speak under oath prior to speaking. All persons who speak during a Public Hearing shall be subject to cross-examination or questioning by any member of the public body, any party to the Public Hearing or any other witness.

- 3. Committee Chairs shall have the unilateral right to have added to or removed from the agenda certain items discussed during their committee meetings. In addition, items may be added to the agenda of a future board meeting upon motion duly made, seconded and passed during any board meeting.
- 4. The Supervisor shall have the unilateral right to have added to or removed from the agenda certain items to be listed under or removed from the Supervisor's report.
- 5. Notwithstanding the foregoing, no member of the board or other person shall seek to have any item added to an agenda and no item shall be removed from any agenda unless at least forty eight (48) hours remain before the time set for the meeting to commence.
- 6. The board, upon motion carried during any meeting, may remove any item or table any item on the agenda of that meeting.

E SUPERVISOR PRO TEM:

A. Election: The township board shall elect one of its members to act as Supervisor pro tem.

B. Duties:

- 1. The Supervisor pro tem shall perform all of the duties of the Supervisor during an absence or disability of the Supervisor. Absence of the Supervisor shall occur whenever the exercise of Supervisor duties and/or powers requires the physical presence of the Supervisor and the Supervisor is not able to be physically present: a) at a previously scheduled event; or b) within an hour following notice given by the township clerk.
- 2. In the event the Supervisor fails to attend a meeting of the Township Board or a portion thereof, the Supervisor pro tem shall chair the meeting. In the absence of both the Supervisor and Supervisor pro tem from a meeting of the Township Board, the Township Board shall elect one of its members to act as a temporary chairman of the meeting.

C. Term: The board member serving as Supervisor pro tem shall serve until:

- 1. Such board member resigns as Supervisor pro tem; or
- 2. Such board member is no longer a township board member.

SECTION 2: This Ordinance shall not be held to repeal a former ordinance as to any offense committed against the former ordinance or as to any act done, any penalty, forfeiture or punishment so incurred, or any right accrued or claim arising under the former ordinance, or in any way whatsoever affect any such offense or act so committed or so done, or any penalty, forfeiture or punishment so incurred to any right accrued to claims arising before this Ordinance takes effect, save only that the proceedings thereafter shall conform to the ordinance in force at the time of such proceedings, as far as practicable.

SECTION 3: That if any part or parts of this Ordinance shall be held to be invalid or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, such invalidity or unconstitutionality shall not affect the validity of the remaining parts of this Ordinance. The Township Board declare hereby that they would have passed the remaining parts of this Ordinance, if they had known that such part or parts thereof would be declared unconstitutional.

SECTION 4: Ordinances and Resolutions, or parts thereof, in conflict herewith, are hereby repealed.

SECTION 5: The Township Clerk of Palos Township is directed hereby to publish this Ordinance in pamphlet form.

SECTION 6: This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval, and publication in pamphlet form.
