The Public Hearing on the Tentative Budget and Appropriation Ordinance for the Road and Bridge District 2018-2019 was called to order by **Highway Commissioner Adams** in the Township Hall, 10802 S. Roberts Road, Palos Hills, at 7:07 P.M. Roll call was taken by the Clerk of the Township, **Jane Nolan.** Present were Trustees Brannigan, Riley and Woods, Supervisor Schumann, and Highway Commissioner Adams. Also present was Road and Bridge District Attorney, Erik Peck, and Road and Bridge District Administrative Assistant, April Schrader.

Absent: Trustee Jeanes

**Trustee Brannigan** moved to open the Public Hearing at 7:08 P.M. **Trustee Riley** seconded the motion. The motion was passed unanimously.

**Trustee Woods** stated that the appropriation in the General Roads Fund is about \$40,000 less than last year. The Hard Road Fund is the same as last year. Decreasing the General Road Fund and increasing the Hard Road Fund allows more work to be done on the streets. He also stated that the budget needs to be re-worked in order to provide the Highway Commissioner with more money. The Road and Bridge District Budget was a much smaller presentation than last year. More information often confuses the public.

**Highway Commissioner Adams** stated that the notice of the Hearing was published in two local newspapers for a period of thirty days, and it was publicly displayed at the Township Hall for that period of time.

There was no written questions sent to the Township concerning the 2018-2019 Budget and Appropriation Ordinance. **Trustee Brannigan** moved to close the 2018-2019 Budget and Appropriation Hearing at 7:11 P.M. **Trustee Riley** seconded the motion. The motion was passed unanimously.

#### **ORDINANCE NO. 2018-0-02**

## AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE SUBMISSION OF AN ADVISORY PUBLIC POLICY QUESTION AT THE NOVEMBER 6, 2018 GENERAL ELECTION, "SHALL THE ILLINOIS GENERAL ASSEMBLY PASS LEGISLATION EXPANDING THE HOMEOWNERS, SENIOR CITIZEN AND VERTERANS PROPERTY TAX EXEMPTIONS TO PROVIDE GREATER PROPERTY TAX RELIEF?"

WHEREAS, pursuant to the authority set forth in Article VII, Section 11 of the Illinois Constitution of 1970, Section 28-5 of the Illinois Election Code (10 ILCS 5/28-5) and Section 80-80 of the Illinois Township Code (60 ILCS 1/80-80), the Township Board of the Township of Palos is authorized to adopt an Ordinance to allow an advisory referendum to appear on the ballot for the November 6, 2018, general election; and

**WHEREAS**, in order to better gauge the sentiments of the residents of the Township, the Township Board of the Township of Palos finds that it is in the best interest of the residents of the Township to approve this Ordinance so that the advisory referendum set forth below in Section 2 shall appear on the ballot for the November 6, 2018, general election.
