Call to Order and Roll Call

The Combined Bill Audit and Road and Bridge District Meeting of the Palos Township Board was called to order by Supervisor Schumann, in the Township Hall, 10802 S. Roberts Road, Palos Hills, at 7:00 P.M. Roll call was taken by the Clerk of the Township, Jane Nolan. Present were Trustees Brannigan, Jeanes, Riley and Woods, Supervisor Schumann, and Highway Commissioner Adams. Also present was Road and Bridge District Attorney, Erik Peck and Road and Bridge District Administrative Assistant. April Schrader.

Pledge of Allegiance

Supervisor Schumann led the assembly on the Pledge of Allegiance.

Disposition of Minutes from Previous Meetings

a. Approval of the Minutes of the Combined Bill Audit and Road and Bridge District Meeting of June 25, 2018

a. Supervisor

Trustee Jeanes seconded the motion. Roll call was taken. Ayes: Trustees Brannigan, Jeanes, Riley and Woods, Supervisor Schumann. Nays: None. Motion carried 5-0.
