- Putnam County High School:
 - Had a very productive meeting with the leadership team at Putnam County High School concerning work-based learning opportunities. All parties were in agreement and willing to help however possible to get students into positive work environments that will benefit the students and their future growth.
 - Additional conversation revolved around the need to get students assessed on the YouScience platform to learn more about the students interests and aptitude which are the two main factors that the program bases the results from. Lack of testing due to COVID-19 which is understandable.






