

The DATE Fund Advisory Committee met on Thursday, October 4, 2018 at approximately 6:00 PM in the Putnam County Administration Building, 117 Putnam Drive, Room 204, Eatonton, Georgia

#### **Opening**

#### 1. Call to Order

Chairman Hersey called the meeting to order at approximately 6:02 p.m. He advised that he was an ex-officio and non-voting member of the committee. He further advised that the purpose of the committee was to make a recommendation to the Board of Commissioners for the expenditure of FY19 Drug Abuse Education and Treatment funds. Chairman Hersey also advised that the FY19 budget was for \$26,500. (Copy of agenda made a part of the minutes.)

#### 2. Discussion of "Treatment" and "Education" Programs

Three main programs were discussed: the Ocmulgee Circuit Adult Treatment Court Collaborative (ATCC), Putnam County DUI Court, and the Putnam County Sheriff's Office (funding for medications, doctors, etc. for inmates with drug and alcohol issues.) The former PCSO DARE program was also discussed. Judge Trammell explained the ATCC program and requested that Putnam County contribute the same as some other counties at the rate of \$2000 per month. Judge Gailey explained the DUI Court program and advised that there is \$10,000 sitting in reserves for this program. Since this program is paid for by the probationers, he agreed



to give up this money, as long as he could keep \$500 in reserve for indigent probationers. Sheriff Sills provided some data on expenditures of his office to take care of inmates with addiction issues. Superintendent Arena explained some of the drug education programs and testing procedures that are done in the school system. Councilwoman Reid stressed the need to expend the money properly and according to code.

#### 3. Recommendation for FY19 Fund Allocation

Motion to release the \$10,000 held in reserve for DUI Court and add it to the \$26,500 budgeted amount and distribute the funds as follows: \$24,000 to ATCC Accountability Court; \$12,000 to PCSO; and \$500 held in reserve for DUI Court.

Motion made by Superintendent Arena, Seconded by Judge Gailey.

Voting Yea: Superintendent Arena, Judge Gailey, Councilwoman Reid, Sheriff Sills, Judge Trammell.

Chairman Hersey advised that the Board of Commissioners wants to receive a report on how the funds are expended.
