14. Discussion and possible action concerning GDOT Highway 44 Project (BS) Chairman Sharp advised that he has received a lot of inquiries on the GDOT Highway 44 Project

and that citizens want to have a say on the widening project. Mr. Brian Quinn distributed a handout and advised that he would like to see GDOT pause their plan to allow public input and is looking for the Board of Commissioners support to hear from constituents.

Ms. Laura Dent commented that she supports a wider road but is concerned about the proposed concrete median in road and vehicles, especially trucks and trailers, having to make U-turns. Chairman Sharp suggested writing a letter to the Governor and State Representatives similar to the letter the Greene County Board of Commissioners sent. Mr. Quinn advised that the Greene County letter does not support hearing from the constituents.

Motion to ask staff to craft a letter to GDOT and state officials asking them to pause and reflect on the current plans for Highway 44, especially from Carey Station Road to Alexander Road, and take into consideration the comments by citizen groups and local businesses and that plans be reviewed and altered to insure the best outcome. There are currently only 16 total slips: four are designated for gas and eight are reserved for the cabins, which only leaves four for the 40 campsites. No action was taken.

Honorable Governor Kemp,

Please accept this letter as official correspondence from the Putnam County Board of Commissioners (hereinafter "Commissioners") in their capacity as the local governing authority for Putnam County Georgia.

The Commissioners have been engaged with the Georgia Department of Transportation (hereinafter "GDOT") for many years on the subject Project (SR 44 widening). County representatives have met with GDOT numerous times over the years to discuss the project, review plans, and provide any local knowledge that could influence the design. Those meetings have always been productive and beneficial.

The Commissioners, however, do not profess to have an expertise in roadway design or engineering. Instead, the Commissioner engage professional engineers to construct a safe and efficient roadway that will properly manage traffic. In the end, the goal is to construct a safe and efficient roadway that will properly manage traffic for the greatest number of years into the future.

The Commissioners are aware of some local efforts seeking to utilize their influence and alter the GDOT proposed design for SR44. Recognizing that GDOT utilizes professional engineers in the development of roadway design that is grounded in proven roadway engineering principles that result in a safe and efficient roadway that operates accordingly for

the greatest length of time. Of course, any such design would anticipate and account for growth.

The Commissioners are familiar with the changes and adjustments that have been made to the GDOT design for SR44 since the initial design was introduced some 20+ years ago. The Commissioners are also aware that GDOT has "fine-tuned" their initial design with the addition of a round-a-bout at the Linger Longer intersection in Greene County. The Commissioners are requesting that GDOT pauses and reviews how the SR44 project impacts Putnam County. Currently, the proposed design forces westbound traffic to make a U-turn to visit any business located on the east side of the highway. There are an inordinate amount of truck and boat trailer traffic that would have to navigate these U turns to utilize the lake, marinas, or associated businesses. In some instances, these vehicles will need to drive into Greene County and turn back east to conduct business in Putnam County. Furthermore, the Commissioners would request that GDOT reviews how the SR44 project terminates at Harmony Road/Old Phoenix Road and the plans for a smooth transition onto a two-lane road.

In closing, the only critical influence desired by the Commissioners is to stress the need to construct the SR44 Project as efficient and effective as possible. The growth experienced in the last few years, primarily driven by COVID when second homes were permanently converted to full-time homes, has resulted in substantial increases in traffic counts. Add the appeal of Lake Oconee and Lake Sinclair, along with continued growth, the need to expedite construction of the Project is easily recognized. The Commissioners fully support the GDOT efforts on this Project and agree with GDOT regarding the need of this project.
