T.P. RESOLUTION NO. R20-02

A resolution authorizing Sewerage District No. 1 of the Parish of Tangipahoa, State of Louisiana to proceed with the issuance, sale and delivery of its not to exceed \$5,650,000 Revenue Bonds, in one or more series.

WHEREAS, as required by Article VI, Section 15 of the Constitution of the State of Louisiana of 1974, as amended, and La. R.S. 33:1415, it is now the desire of the Parish Council, as the governing authority of the Parish of Tangipahoa, State of Louisiana (the "Parish") to approve the issuance and delivery of not to exceed \$5,650,000 Revenue Bonds, in one or more series (the "Bonds"), by Sewerage District No. 1 of the Parish of Tangipahoa, State of Louisiana (the "District"), the proceeds of which will be used by the District to acquire, construct, extend and improve the sewerage system owned by and located within the District (the "System").

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Parish Council, as the governing authority of the Parish:

SECTION 1. That, in compliance with the provisions of Article VI, Section 15 of the Constitution of the State of Louisiana of 1974, as amended, and La. R.S. 33:1415, and in accordance with the request of the Board of Supervisors of the District, the Parish Council approves the issuance and delivery of not to exceed \$5,650,000 Revenue Bonds of the District, in one or more series. The Bonds shall bear interest at a fixed rate or rates not exceeding six percent (6.00%) per annum, shall mature no later than thirty (30) years from the date of issuance thereof, and shall be issued under the authority of Section 1430 of Title 39 of the Louisiana Revised Statutes of 1950, as

amended, and other constitutional and statutory authority, or such other authority as may be determined by resolution of the District at the time of the issuance of the Bonds. SECTION 2. The Parish President, the Council Chairman and the Council Clerk are hereby authorized and directed to do any and all things necessary and incidental to carry out the provisions of this resolution and to assist the District in carrying out its functions in connection with the financing.
