

Attached is the revised quote submitted by Kelly Construction for the suspended acoustical ceiling. The light originally specified had already been ordered but was able to be traded out as an even swap for the two led layin fixtures. And the diffuser line item was removed. Joe and Bobby went over the rest of the quantities and realized he had used the wrong scale when doing the takeoff, so those costs went down \$671 for a total of \$1,594. It is still higher than we would have anticipated. Please let me know if you would like to proceed with the work and I will advise Kelly.

Now that we have an installation date from Schindler, we need to address the number of days we will need to complete the installation and reach substantial completion.

As you and Mr. Fred are well aware, we have done all we could do up to this point to accommodate Schindler Elevator and the manner in which their requirements trickled in piece mill limiting our ability to confirm our readiness 100% until just recently.

But now that we do have an install date, we need to request the additional days to complete their install be added to our contract via this CPR.

We are requesting an additional 68 days be added to the contract schedule which would give us a new completion date of August 14, 2023. We feel this will allow enough time for their installation and for us to execute the punch list afterwards.

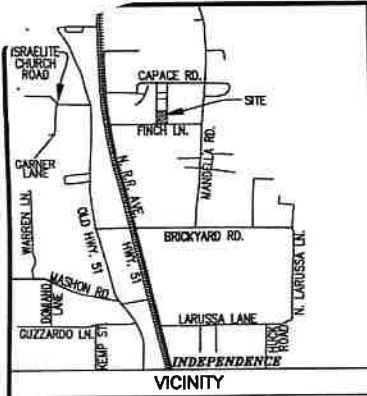

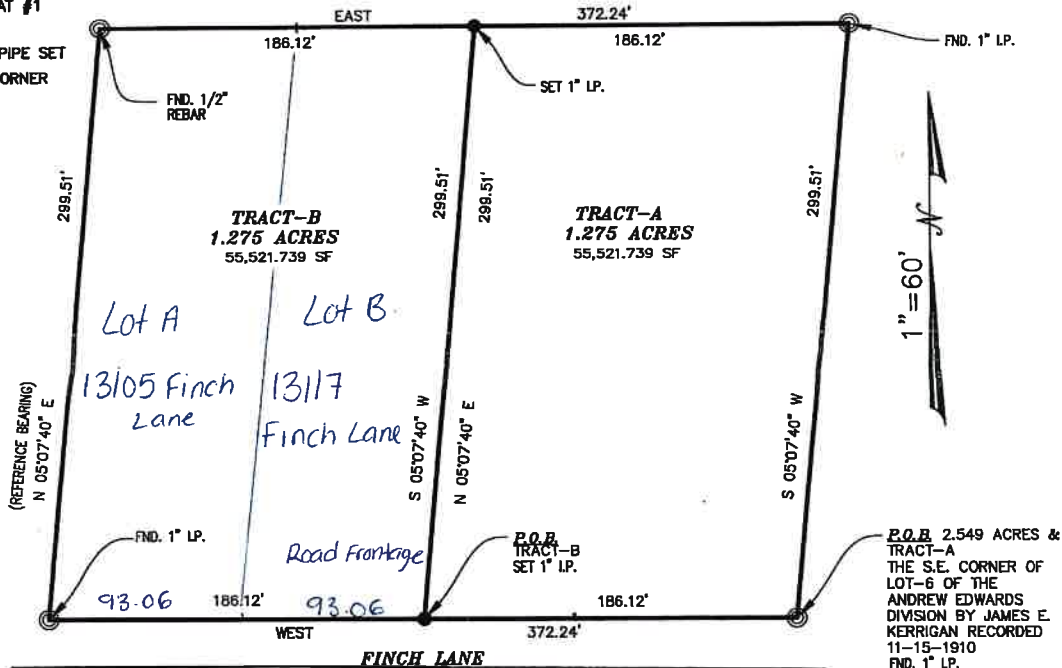

COOPERATIVE ENDEAVOR AGREEMENT

This Agreement is entered into by and between the **TANGIPAHOA PARISH SCHOOL BOARD**, represented through its authorized representative (“TPSB”), the **TANGIPAHOA PARISH LIBRARY BOARD**, represented herein through its authorized representative (“TPLB”) and **THE TANGIPAHOA PARISH COUNCIL-PRESIDENT GOVERNMENT** represented through its authorized representative (“Parish”), who declared as follows:

WHEREAS, Article VII, Section 14(C) of the Constitution of the State of Louisiana provides that “For a public purpose, the state and its political subdivisions or political corporations may engage in cooperative endeavors with each other, with the United States or its agencies, or with any public or private association, corporation, or individual.”;

WHEREAS, the TPSB acquired forty (40) acres fronting on La Hwy 1062 in Loranger for the purpose of constructing a new school/addition to the Loranger schools; and

WHEREAS, applicable accreditation rules require a library to be included in the new school building(s)/additions; and

WHEREAS, the Parish has agreed to purchase from the TPSB two (2) acres of land out of the forty acre parcel (the “Library Property”), with the understanding and agreement that the Parish and/or TPLB will build a new public library on the two acre parcel; and

WHEREAS, the Parish and the TPLB have agreed that students at the Loranger schools will have a priority of use of the new library such that the TPSB will not have to include a library in the new construction and still meet its accreditation requirements, and thereby using its facilities for other needs; and

WHEREAS, the TPSB, TPLB and Parish desire to enter into this cooperative endeavor agreement for their mutual benefit as stated above and to enhance the academic and educational enhancement of students at Loranger and the public in general in their use of the new library.

Now, therefore, in consideration of the mutual covenants herein contained, the public purpose; and the public benefit as herein stated, the parties hereto agree as follows:

SCOPE OF AGREEMENT

1. The Parish/TPLB agree to construct a new public library on the Library Property. The Parish/TPLB agree to provide priority access to the new Library to Loranger students, faculty, staff and administration to meet accreditation requirements. Any priority use must be scheduled in advance.

2. The Parish/TPLB agrees to use its best efforts to have available in the library any books or reading materials required for TPSB accreditation purposes.

3. All parties agree to cooperate and provide assistance as needed for their mutual benefit to the fullest extent allowed by law.
