A Resolution granting approval to Consolidated Gravity Drainage District No. 1 of the Parish of Tangipahoa, Louisiana (the “*District*”), to call and hold an election on Saturday, December 5, 2020, to authorize the renewal of a five (5) mills tax on assessed valuation of all property subject to taxation in the District, for a period of ten (10) years for the purpose of acquiring, constructing, improving, maintaining or operating drainage works of public improvement in the District, and implementing a Comprehensive Master Drainage Plan within the territorial limits of the District; and further making application to the State Bond Commission for consent and authorization to hold the aforesaid election; and further providing for other matters in connection therewith.

WHEREAS, Consolidated Gravity Drainage District No. 1 of the Parish of Tangipahoa, Louisiana (the “*District*”) adopted a Resolution on July 29, 2020 ordering and calling a special election to be held in the District on SATURDAY, DECEMBER 5, 2020, to authorize the renewal of the levy and collection of a five (5) mills ad valorem tax for a period of ten (10) years, beginning in the year 2022 and ending in the year 2031, for the purpose of acquiring, constructing, improving, maintaining or operating drainage works of public improvement in the District, and implementing a Comprehensive Master Drainage Plan within the territorial limits of the District (the “*Tax*”), all in the manner conferred by La. R.S. 38:1902, Article VI, Sections 30 and 32 of the Louisiana Constitution of 1974, as amended, and the applicable provisions of Chapter 6 and Chapter 6-A of Title 18 of the Louisiana Revised Statutes of 1950, as amended, and other constitutional and statutory authority (the “*District Resolution*”), a copy of which is on file with the Parish Council of the Parish of Tangipahoa, State of Louisiana, as governing authority of the Parish of Tangipahoa, State of Louisiana (the “*Parish Council*”);

WHEREAS, the District has made application to the Parish Council for approval to call and hold such election on SATURDAY, DECEMBER 5, 2020, as more fully set forth in the District Resolution;

WHEREAS, Article VI, Section 15 of the Louisiana Constitution of 1974, as amended, and Section 1415 of Title 33 of the Louisiana Revised Statutes of 1950, as amended, grants power to the Parish Council to approve any proposal submitted by the District to levy a tax;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Parish Council, as the governing authority of the Parish of Tangipahoa, State of Louisiana, that:

SECTION 1. Pursuant to a request submitted to this Parish Council by the District, approval is hereby granted to the District to call and hold an election on SATURDAY, DECEMBER 5, 2020, to authorize the renewal of the levy and collection of a five (5) mills ad valorem tax for a period of ten (10) years, beginning in the year 2022 and ending in the year 2031, for the purpose of acquiring, constructing, improving, maintaining or operating drainage works of public improvement in the District, and implementing a Comprehensive Master Drainage Plan within the territorial limits of the District (the “*Tax*”), in the manner conferred by La. R.S. 38:1902, Article VI, Sections 30 and 32 of the Louisiana Constitution of 1974, as amended, and the applicable provisions of Chapter 6 and Chapter 6-A of Title 18 of the Louisiana Revised Statutes of 1950, and other constitutional and statutory authority and as more fully set forth in the District Resolution.

SECTION 2. In the event the foregoing proposition passes, approval, consent and authority are hereby granted to the District to levy and collect the Tax described in Section 1 hereof.

SECTION 3. This approval is granted in compliance with the provisions of Article VI, Section 15 of the Louisiana Constitution of 1974, as amended, and Section 1415 of Title 33 of the Louisiana Revised Statutes of 1950, as amended.

**Residential Antidisplacement and Relocation Assistance Plan
As Required Under Section 104(D) of the
Housing and Community Development Act of 1974, as Amended**

The Tangipahoa Parish Government will replace all occupied and vacant occupiable low/moderate-income dwelling units demolished or converted to a use other than as low/moderate-income housing as a direct result of activities assisted with funds provided under the Housing and Community Development Act of 1974, as amended, as described in 24 CFR 570.606(b)(1). The Tangipahoa Parish Government Antidisplacement contact person is Mrs. Bridget Bailey, Parish Planner, who can be reached at (985) 340-9028.

All replacement housing will be provided within three (3) years of the commencement of the demolition or rehabilitation relating to conversion. Before obligating or expending funds that will directly result in such demolition or conversion, the Parish Government will notify the public and submit to the Division of Administration the following information in writing:

1. A description of the proposed assisted activity;
2. The general location on a map and approximate number of dwelling units by size (number of bedrooms) that will be demolished or converted to a use other than low/moderate-income dwelling units as a direct result of the assisted activity;
3. A time schedule for the commencement and completion of the demolition or conversion;
4. The general location on a map and approximate number of dwelling units by size (number of bedrooms) that will be provided as replacement dwelling units;
5. The source of funding and a time schedule for the provision of replacement dwelling units; and
6. The basis for concluding that each replacement dwelling unit will remain in a low/moderate-income unit for at least ten (10) years from the date of initial occupancy.

The Tangipahoa Parish Government will provide relocation assistance, as described in 570.606(b)(2), to each low/moderate-income household displaced by the demolition of housing or by the conversion of a low/moderate-income dwelling to another use as a direct result of assisted activities.

Consistent with the goals and objectives of activities assisted under the Act, the Parish will take the following steps to minimize the displacement of persons from their homes:

1. All infrastructure projects will be designed so that there will be no displacement of any residences or businesses;
2. No homes will be demolished that can be rehabilitated; and
3. There will be no displacement of any residential or business occupants on CDBG—Disaster Recovery projects.
