WHEREAS, the Tangipahoa Parish Code of Ordinances Chapter 10, Section 10-100 (a) the parish animal control department shall, with the approval of the parish council, set reasonable fees for charged services; and

#### T. P. RESOLUTION NO. R25-07

A RESOLUTION OF THE TANGIPAHOA PARISH COUNCIL-PRESIDENT GOVERNMENT FOR COOPER SALVAGE YARD, INC, 24333 HWY 22, PONCHATOULA, LA TO PROCEED WITH THE PERMITTING PROCESS FOR AN AUTO BODY DISMANTLE ONLY LICENSE IN DISTRICT 9, TANGIPAHOA PARISH

WHEREAS, Cooper Salvage Yard, Inc. located at 24333 Hwy 22, Ponchatoula, LA, in Districts 9 has submitted an application to the Technical Review Committee for an Auto Body Dismantle Only License in Tangipahoa Parish; and

WHEREAS, an Auto Body Dismantle Only license strictly consists of car body part removal only, no engine type of parts that involve fluids, oils, or gas of any kind; and

WHEREAS, Chapter 36, Article VIII, Section 36-223 provides the procedure and regulations for Automobile/Vehicle impound facilities, automobile/vehicle salvage facilities, used car sales and recycling facilities with specific regulation applying to an Auto Body Dismantle Only License being;

- (4) Additional operational standards.
  - a. Materials collected in storage must be stored with like materials and must be stored in a manner to prevent the harboring of vectors and shall not create an unpleasant or unsightly view.
  - b. Water will not be allowed to collect or hold within the stored automobile, vehicle and/or stored recyclable material to promote the breeding of rodents, vermin, roaches, mosquitos or other nuisances.
  - c. Rodents, vermin, roaches, mosquitos and other pests will be controlled on the premises by regular treatment of the site with insecticides and rodent bait.
  - d. Upon the discovery by the parish building inspector that any person, corporation, company, partnership or other entity is in violation of this article, then such person, corporation, company, partnership or other entity shall be given 48 hours' written notice to cure or correct the violation and in failing to do so then to cease operations. If the violation continues after this notice and the passage of 48 hours from receipt of such a written notice, then the violators shall be subject to such criminal fines and civil penalties as may be provided for in this Code.
  - e. The failure to comply with the above requirements or to obtain a permit prior to beginning operation of any automobile/vehicle impound facility, an automobile/vehicle salvage facility and/or a recycling facility or the later operating of any such facility in violation thereof shall be punished by a civil fine of \$500.00 per day for each day that the violation continues. Each 24-hour period that a violation continues shall be a separate violation and subject to said fine of \$500.00 per day.
  - f. The violation shall be deemed to continue until all material contained on the property has been removed from the property and/or a certificate of compliance for this section has been issued by the parish permit office.
  - g. The provisions of this article shall apply prospectively from December 13, 1999; however these regulatory provisions shall not interfere with the operations of junk yards in existence, validly operating pursuant to validly issued permits and doing business as a junk yard on December 13, 1999, except that all junk yards will be reclassified and be required to obtain a permit pursuant to this article.

WHEREAS, the Cooper Salvage Yard, Inc. Auto Body Dismantle Only license preliminary process per Section 36-220 has been reviewed by the Technical Review Committee and recommended for consideration by the Council; and

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Tangipahoa Parish Council acting as the governing authority does hereby find that Cooper Salvage Yard, Inc. application complies with the requirements of the Tangipahoa Parish Code of Ordinances for the preliminary process approval and doe hereby authorize the Technical Review Committee to proceed with the final permitting process and issue such approvals as necessary for an Auto Body Dismantle Only license as proposed by Cooper Salvage Yard, Inc.

A RESOLUTION OF THE TANGIPAHOA PARISH COUNCIL-PRESIDENT GOVERNMENT FOR S&J AUTOBODY & MECHANICS, 18226 WOODSCALE ROAD, HAMMOND, LA TO PROCEED WITH THE PERMITTING PROCESS FOR AN AUTO BODY DISMANTLE ONLY LICENSE IN DISTRICT 8, TANGIPAHOA PARISH

WHEREAS, S&J Autobody & Mechanics located at 18226 Woodscale Road, Hammond, LA, in Districts 8 has submitted an application to the Technical Review Committee for an Auto Body Dismantle Only License in Tangipahoa Parish; and

WHEREAS, an Auto Body Dismantle Only license consists of no type of parts that involve fluids of any kind; and

WHEREAS, Chapter 36, Article VIII, Section 36-223 provides the procedure and regulations for Automobile/Vehicle impound facilities, automobile/vehicle salvage facilities, used car sales and recycling facilities with specific regulation applying to an Auto Body Dismantle Only License being;

- (4) Additional operational standards.
  - a. Materials collected in storage must be stored with like materials and must be stored in a manner to prevent the harboring of vectors and shall not create an unpleasant or unsightly view.
  - b. Water will not be allowed to collect or hold within the stored automobile, vehicle and/or stored recyclable material to promote the breeding of rodents, vermin, roaches, mosquitos or other nuisances.
  - c. Rodents, vermin, roaches, mosquitos and other pests will be controlled on the premises by regular treatment of the site with insecticides and rodent bait.
  - d. Upon the discovery by the parish building inspector that any person, corporation, company, partnership or other entity is in violation of this article, then such person, corporation, company, partnership or other entity shall be given 48 hours' written notice to cure or correct the violation and in failing to do so then to cease operations. If the violation continues after this notice and the passage of 48 hours from receipt of such a written notice, then the violators shall be subject to such criminal fines and civil penalties as may be provided for in this Code.
  - e. The failure to comply with the above requirements or to obtain a permit prior to beginning operation of any automobile/vehicle impound facility, an automobile/vehicle salvage facility and/or a recycling facility or the later operating of any such facility in violation thereof shall be punished by a civil fine of \$500.00 per day for each day that the violation continues. Each 24-hour period that a violation continues shall be a separate violation and subject to said fine of \$500.00 per day.
  - f. The violation shall be deemed to continue until all material contained on the property has been removed from the property and/or a certificate of compliance for this section has been issued by the parish permit office.
  - g. The provisions of this article shall apply prospectively from December 13, 1999; however these regulatory provisions shall not interfere with the operations of junk yards in existence, validly operating pursuant to validly issued permits and doing business as a junk yard on December 13, 1999, except that all junk yards will be reclassified and be required to obtain a permit pursuant to this article.

WHEREAS, the Cooper Salvage Yard, Inc. Auto Body Dismantle Only license preliminary process per Section 36-220 has been reviewed by the Technical Review Committee and recommended for consideration by the Council; and
