An ordinance creating "Tangipahoa Parish Economic Development District No. 8, State of Louisiana;" defining the boundaries thereof from which area local tax increments may be determined and used to finance economic development projects in accordance with and as authorized by Part II of Chapter 27 of Title 33 of the Louisiana Revised Statutes of 1950, as amended; and providing for other matters in connection with the foregoing.

WHEREAS, Part II, Chapter 27, Title 33 of the Louisiana Revised Statutes of 1950, as amended (La. R.S. 33:9038.31, et seq.) (the "Act") authorizes municipalities, parishes and certain other local governmental subdivisions to create economic development districts to carry out the purposes of the Act, which economic development districts are political subdivisions of the State of Louisiana and possess such power and authority and have such duties as provided by the Act and other law; and

WHEREAS, the Parish of Tangipahoa, State of Louisiana (the "Parish"), acting through this Parish Council as its governing authority, desires to avail itself of the Act to create an economic development district to be called "Tangipahoa Parish Economic Development District No. 8, State of Louisiana" (the "District"), in accordance with La. R.S. 33:9038.32, from which District local and State sales tax and/or hotel occupancy tax increments are expected to be determined and used to fund the Tangipahoa Parish Economic Development District No. 8, State of Louisiana Trust Fund; and

WHEREAS, La. R.S. 33:9038.39 further permits such economic development districts to levy sales and use taxes and hotel occupancy taxes at a rate up to two percent (2%) for authorized purposes; and

WHEREAS, La. R.S. 33:9038.34(O) provides that this governing authority may create a special trust fund for the furtherance of economic development projects, as defined in the Act, into which the incremental increases in such taxes shall be deposited and loaned, granted, donated, or pledged in furtherance of economic development projects as defined in the Act; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with the Act, particularly La. R.S. 33:9038.32(B) and La. R.S. 33:9038.39, and a resolution adopted on March 22, 2021, the Parish has given notice of its intention to create the District, and notice that it will hold a public hearing relative to the proposed creation of the District, including a description of the boundaries of the District and containing a map showing the boundaries of the District, which notice has been published once a week for two weeks in the Parish's official journal; and

WHEREAS, on this date, prior to the adoption of this ordinance, this governing authority did hold a public hearing pursuant to the aforesaid notice of intention, at which public hearing no objections were received with respect to the creation of the District;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY ORDAINED by the Parish Council of the Parish of Tangipahoa, State of Louisiana, acting as the governing authority of the Parish of Tangipahoa, State of Louisiana, that:

SECTION 1. All of the above "Whereas" clauses are adopted as part of this ordinance.

SECTION 2. <u>Creation of District</u>. Under the authority of La. R.S. 33:9038.32 there is hereby created an economic development district within the Parish, to be named "Tangipahoa Parish Economic Development District No. 8, State of Louisiana," having the geographical boundaries set forth in Exhibit A attached hereto, which Exhibit A is hereby incorporated in and made a part of this Ordinance, all pursuant to the Act. As provided by the Act, the governing body of the District shall be this Parish Council. As provided by the Act, the District shall be a political subdivision of the State of Louisiana and shall possess such powers and authority and have such duties as provided in the Act and other law.

SECTION 3. <u>Creation of Trust Fund</u>. Under the authority of La. R.S. 33:9038.34(O), there is hereby created a special trust fund, to be named the "Tangipahoa Parish Economic Development District No. 8, State of Louisiana Trust Fund" (the "Trust Fund") the purpose of which will be to fund economic development projects selected by the District in the manner provided by the Act. The Trust Fund shall be established by the Director of Finance of the Parish and maintained as a separate fund, apart from other funds and accounts of the Parish or other entities, and shall be used strictly for the purposes set forth herein and in the Act.

SECTION 4. <u>Authorization of Officers</u>. The Parish President, Council Chair and Council Clerk are hereby authorized, empowered and directed to do any and all things necessary and incidental to carry out the provisions of this ordinance.

SECTION 5. <u>Severability</u>. If any provision of this ordinance shall be held to be illegal or invalid, such illegality or invalidity shall not affect any other provision of this ordinance, but this ordinance shall be construed and enforced as if such illegal or invalid provisions had not been contained herein. Any constitutional or statutory provision enacted after the date of this ordinance which validates or makes legal any provision of this ordinance which would not otherwise be valid or legal, shall be deemed to apply to this ordinance.

SECTION 6. <u>Repealer</u>. All ordinances or resolution, or parts thereof, in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION 7. <u>Publication; Effective Date</u>. This ordinance shall be published one time in the official journal of the Parish and in accordance with Section 2-12(C) of the Tangipahoa Parish Home Rule Charter, shall become effective immediately upon approval by the Parish President.

Subject: 3 Way Stop Sign at General Ott Rd. and Hinson Rd.

Mr. Mayeaux and Ms. Coates,

After careful consideration, I recommend a 3-way stop sign at the intersection of General Ott Rd and Hinson Rd. This recommendation is based on topography, sight distance, geometric layout, design speed, and current configuration. Currently, there is a stop sign headed south bound on Hinson Rd. at the subject intersection. The sight distance for drivers headed East on General Ott Rd. turning left onto Hinson Rd is insufficient. Also, the geometric layout of the intersection is undesirable. The 90-degree curve does not have proper super elevation for this degree of curvature. These deficiencies suggest the need for a 3-Way Stop configuration.
