T.P. ORDINANCE NO. 20-60

ORDINANCE TO AMEND AND REENACT ORDINANCE 36 OF 1988 WHICH REGULATES SEWAGE DISPOSAL SYSTEMS TO ALLOW CERTAIN OPTIONS TO THE CURRENT SEWER INSPECTION POLICY

WHEREAS the Parish of Tangipahoa would be better served by allowing certain options to the current sewer inspection policy to allow for automatic turn-ons and under certain situations where sewer systems have been recently inspected at commercial facilities including mobile home parks and multi-family apartment complexes.

WHEREAS, the Tangipahoa Parish Council now desires to expand Section 23-27(c) to add an Automatic Turn On Program and to add subsection (d).

THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED Ordinance 36 of 1988 hereby be amended as indicated below and reenacted by the Tangipahoa Parish Council, State of Louisiana, acting as the governing authority thereof as follows:

- (a) Every new or existing premises, public or private, where people live, work or congregate shall be provided with approved toilet facilities, including handwashing facilities. Such facilities shall be properly connected to a public sewage system where available or to a private sewage disposal system specifically approved for the premises by the state health officer or duly authorized representative, after determining that the installation and operation of the individual system will not create a nuisance or public health hazard. It shall be the duty of the owner, manager or agent of any occupied premises, public or private, where people live or work to provide an approved method of sewage disposal.
- (b) Existing mobile homes and permanent structures will be exempt for the period of time that the present owner or occupant of the property inhabits the premises.
- (c) At the time of change of ownership, occupancy or location, the mobile home or structure shall be required to have a health permit secured in the same manner as covering new dwellings as set forth hereinabove. **Except as provided for in the exceptions contained in section (d) below.**
- (d) **Certain Multi-family properties may participate in the Entergy Automatic Turn-On (“ATO”) program. These owners may apply to have an annual permit that will allow the property owner or manager to receive an ATO permit without the necessity of a new inspection. Properties that can apply for this program will include Multiple Unit housing with Extended Air Plants and Multiple Unit housing with Oxidation Ponds. ATO property owners must have their systems inspected annually. If any ATO Program property falls out of compliance, then the property will be removed from this program until it is compliant as determined by the Parish Sanitarian Manager. The previous “permanently exempt program” will be replaced with the new ATO Program. Properties participating in the “permanent exempt program” at the time of the adoption of this ordinance will be transferred to the ATO Program if the property has the approved sewer system.**

Sec.23-28. Mobile home installations—Requirements for normal dwelling units, individual sewage systems apply.

The mobile home or modular home installation shall comply with all requirements for location of a normal dwelling unit and all requirements for individual sewage systems shall apply.

Sec. 23-29. - Permit.

Except for existing mobile homes and permanent structures, during the period of time that the present owner or occupant of the property inhabits the premises, as exempted hereinabove, no sewage system shall be used or placed in operation without approval in the form of a permit issued by the state health officer or his duly authorized representative. For purposes of this article, a new permit shall be required upon the initial installation of a sewage disposal system and, additionally, required each time the occupancy of the premises changes. For the purpose of convenience, the landlord, owner, manager or agent, may acquire for the period of one year on rental property, an approved sewage permit. It shall be the duty of any of the above to obtain, make available and provide this permit to the renter of the property. It shall also be the responsibility of any of the above to obtain such approved sewage permit each year thereafter. Violation of this section shall constitute an offense and shall be punishable as provided in section 1-13. Each day that a violation is permitted to exist shall constitute a separate offense. It shall be the responsibility of the owner or owners in whose name electrical utilities are secured to obtain the permit required herein.

Sec. 23-30. - Inspection.

Before final approval is issued, the state health officer or his authorized agent shall inspect the installed sewage disposal system.

Sec. 23-31. - Permit prerequisite to obtaining permanent utility service.

No electrical utility company licensed to do or doing business in the parish shall install or connect permanent service to any mobile home until a final permit is issued. No electrical utility company licensed to do or doing business in the parish shall install or connect temporary service to any other structure unless a work authorization has been issued by the parish nor install or connect a permanent electrical service until final permit has been issued by the state health officer as required in this article

Sec. 23-34. - Penalty.

Any person who violates any of the provisions of this article shall be punished as provided in section 1-13.

T.P. Ordinance No. 20-62

"AN ORDINANCE TO DESIGNATE THAT PORTION OF MACEDONIA ROAD AT 40065 MACEDONIA ROAD WHERE JUST KIDDIN AROUND CHILD CARE AND PRESCHOOL IS LOCATED AS A SCHOOL ZONE"

WHEREAS, the Just Kiddin Around Child Care and Preschool is a school; and

WHEREAS, the children at the Just Kiddin Around Child Care and Preschool are in need of the protections afforded by designating the area of Macedonia Road adjacent to Just Kiddin Around Child Care and Preschool as a school zone.

THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Tangipahoa Parish Council, the legislative branch of parish government, which along with the Parish President of Tangipahoa Parish, Louisiana constitute the parish government, the said Tangipahoa Parish Council-President Government having a Home Rule form of government and acting pursuant to the authority of that Home Rule Charter which became effective on October 27, 1986 as follows:

That in accordance with Chapter 20, Streets, Roads, Sidewalks and Drainage - Article I in General - Section 20-16, there is hereby designated a school zone six hundred (600) feet in length on Macedonia Road centered at the Just Kiddin Around Child Care and Preschool located at 40065 Macedonia Road, Ponchatoula, Tangipahoa Parish, Louisiana.

In connection with this designation as a school zone, road signs shall be place three hundred (300) feet East and three hundred (300) feet West of Just Kiddin Around Child Care and Preschool designating this area as a school zone and reducing the speed limit to 20 miles per hour during the hours of 7:00 o'clock a.m. until 6:00 o'clock p.m. These signs shall be constructed in substantially the same form as these signs used by the Louisiana Department of Transportation and Development for public schools on state highways.

The failure to drive a vehicle within the posted limit during the scheduled time on school days shall subject the offender to the general criminal penalties prescribed in Section 1-13 of Chapter One of the Code of Ordinances for Tangipahoa Parish, Louisiana.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED by the Tangipahoa Parish Council that this ordinance shall take effect immediately upon the signature of the Tangipahoa Parish President.
