Pursuant to Louisiana law, Revised Statutes R.S. 39:1301 – 1315, Local Government Budget Act, I hereby submit to you for your review and consideration the proposed operating budget for the Tangipahoa Parish Rural Fire Protection District No. 2 ("Fire District") for the year ending December 31, 2019. The following is a summary of the more significant information contained in this proposed budget.

Summary Description of the Proposed Financial Plan, Policies, and Objectives:

The financial plan for Fire District is expected to remain basically the same in 2019 as the financial plan was for 2018. Ad valorem tax revenue is projected, based on the tax rolls prepared by the Tangipahoa Parish Assessor, to increase approximately 1.39% from the amount budgeted for 2018. All other revenues are anticipated to remain the same in 2019 as they were in 2018.

Significant Revenue Assumptions:

- Ad valorem tax Based on the tax rolls prepared by the Tangipahoa Parish Assessor, ad valorem
 tax is expected to increase by (1.39%) in 2019 over the amount for 2018. The allowance for
 uncollected ad valorem tax is estimated to be 2.00% of total taxes to be collected.
- State revenue sharing This revenue item is expected to be the same in 2019 as in 2018.
- 2% fire insurance rebate This revenue item is expected to be the same in 2019 as 2018.
- Municipal fire contracts This revenue item is expected to be the same in 2019 as 2018.

Significant Expenditure Assumptions:

- Administrative This expenditure category is expected to remain the same in 2019 as it was in 2018.
- Payments to fire departments This expenditure category is expected to increase by \$74,000 in 2019 from the amount budgeted in 2018 due primarily to the anticipated increase in property tax collections.

Budgetary Basis of Accounting:

To facilitate the analysis of the financial resources available to the Fire District for 2019, this Proposed Budget for 2019 has been prepared on the modified accrual basis of accounting. Under this method of

accounting, revenues are recognized in the period in which they become measurable and available. The Fire District considers all revenues available if they are collected within 60 days after year-end. Interest income is recorded as earned. Federal and state reimbursement-type grants are recorded as revenue when related eligible expenditures are incurred. Expenditures are recorded when the financial obligation to pay is incurred.

Other Significant Budgetary Items:

The budget for 2019 includes \$10,000 to fund the Swiftwater program.
