**A RESOLUTION GRANTING APPROVAL TO THE MOSQUITO ABATEMENT DISTRICT NO. 1 OF THE PARISH OF TANGIPAOHA, STATE OF LOUISIANA (THE "DISTRICT") TO CALL AND HOLD AN ELECTION ON MARCH 29, 2025, TO REQUEST THE ELECTORATE OF DISTRICT TO RENEW THE LEVY AND COLLECTION OF A SPECIAL AD VALOREM TAX IN THE DISTRICT AND FURTHER PROVIDING FOR OTHER MATTERS IN CONNECTION THEREWITH.**

**WHEREAS**, the Board of Commissioners (the "**Board**"), acting as the governing authority, of Mosquito Abatement District No. 1 of the Parish of Tangipahoa, State of Louisiana (the "**District**"), has previously given notice of its intent to call an election requesting the authority to renew, levy and collect a special ad valorem tax of four and ninety eight (4.98) mills on all the property subject to taxation in the District, for a period of ten (10) years commencing with the year 2027 and annually thereafter, to and including the tax collection for the year 2036 (the "**Tax**"); and

**WHEREAS**, at its meeting anticipated to be held on November 6, 2024, the District will adopt a resolution calling for an election (the "**Resolution**") to be held on March 29, 2025 (the "**Election**") for the electorate of the District to consider the question of the imposition of the Tax; and

**WHEREAS**, the Parish Council of the Parish of Tangipahoa, State of Louisiana (the "**Parish Council**"), acting as the governing authority of the Parish of Tangipahoa, State of Louisiana (the "**Parish**") desires to affirm the authority of the District to call the Election, and in the event that the Election carries, to levy and collect the Tax as provided for therein.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Parish Council of the Parish that:

1. **SECTION 1. Approval of District Elections.** Following the adoption of the Resolution by the District at its meeting on November 6, 2024, this Parish Council hereby affirms and consents to the authority of the District to call the Election for the Tax, to the extent allowable by the constitution and laws of the State of Louisiana, and to levy same following the approval of the qualified electors of the District at said Election. Additionally, this Parish Council hereby approves and consents to the holding of an Election in the District on Saturday, March 29, 2025, at which election there will be submitted proposition, to-wit:

(RENEWAL)**

Shall Mosquito Abatement District No. 1 of the Parish of Tangipahoa, State of Louisiana (the "District") renew the levy and collection of a tax of four and ninety eight hundredths (4.98) mills on all property subject to taxation within the District (an estimated \$3,014,208 reasonably expected at this time to be collected from the levy of the tax for an entire year) (the "Tax") for a period of ten (10) years, beginning with the year 2027 and ending with the year 2036, for the purpose of acquiring, purchasing, maintaining and operating machinery, facilities, equipment and materials necessary or useful in the eradication, abatement or control of mosquitoes and other arthropods of public health importance?

**SECTION 2. Levy and Collection.** In the event the Election carries, this Parish Council does hereby further authorize and consent to the District levying and collecting the Tax provided for herein.
