A RESOLUTIONO SUPPORTING IMPLEMENTATION OF 2045 TANGIPAHOA PARISH COMPREHENSIVE PLAN, ADOPTED ON NOVEMBER 7, 2023, AND RAISING AWARENESS OF OUTREACH AND ENGAGEMENT EFFORTS UNDERWAY FOR RELATED LAND USE IMPLEMENTATION EFFORTS IN PROGRESS FOR WHICH A COMMUNITY ENGAGEMENT EVENT IS SCHEDULED FOR DECEMBER 11, 2024, AT 6:00PM AT THE TANGIPAHOA PARISH PLANNING DEPARTMENT CONFERENCE ROOM

WHEREAS, in 2023, the Planning Department, Planning Commission, and Parish Council worked with various parish departments, stakeholders, and the public to update and adopt the 2045 Tangipahoa Parish Comprehensive Plan (herein after referred to as “the Plan”); and

WHEREAS, the Plan establishes a long-range vision for Tangipahoa Parish to year 2045 that will foster more sustainable long-term development patterns and projects; and

WHEREAS, the Plan Vision is “In 2045, Tangipahoa Parish is a vibrant and secure environment where residents enjoy historic connections to nature and the Parish’s agricultural heritage, while also reaping the benefits of robust infrastructure, a balanced approach to growth and development, a thriving economy, and a strong and innovative education system;” and

WHEREAS, to achieve this Vision, the Plan includes short-, medium-, and long-term strategies that aim to advance improvements to infrastructure and critical facilities, economic development, land use planning, the environment, and quality of life for residents and business owners; and

WHEREAS, on November 27, 2023, the Parish Council acknowledged the adoption of the Plan and resolved (Res. No. R23-44) to work together with the Planning Commission and the Administration to implement the Plan to achieve the Community Vision for 2045 and support the public’s health, safety, and welfare; and

WHEREAS, Tangipahoa Parish is working with a consultant to advance implementation of the Plan’s land use planning recommendations in 2 phases; and

WHEREAS, the Parish Council and Administration recognizes the importance of engaging residents and businesses across the parish and seeks to raise awareness of this planning effort; and

WHEREAS, the Parish Council and Administration encourage the public’s participation and feedback in this important parishwide planning effort, and notify the public of the first community engagement event on:

December 11, 2024, at 6:00pm
