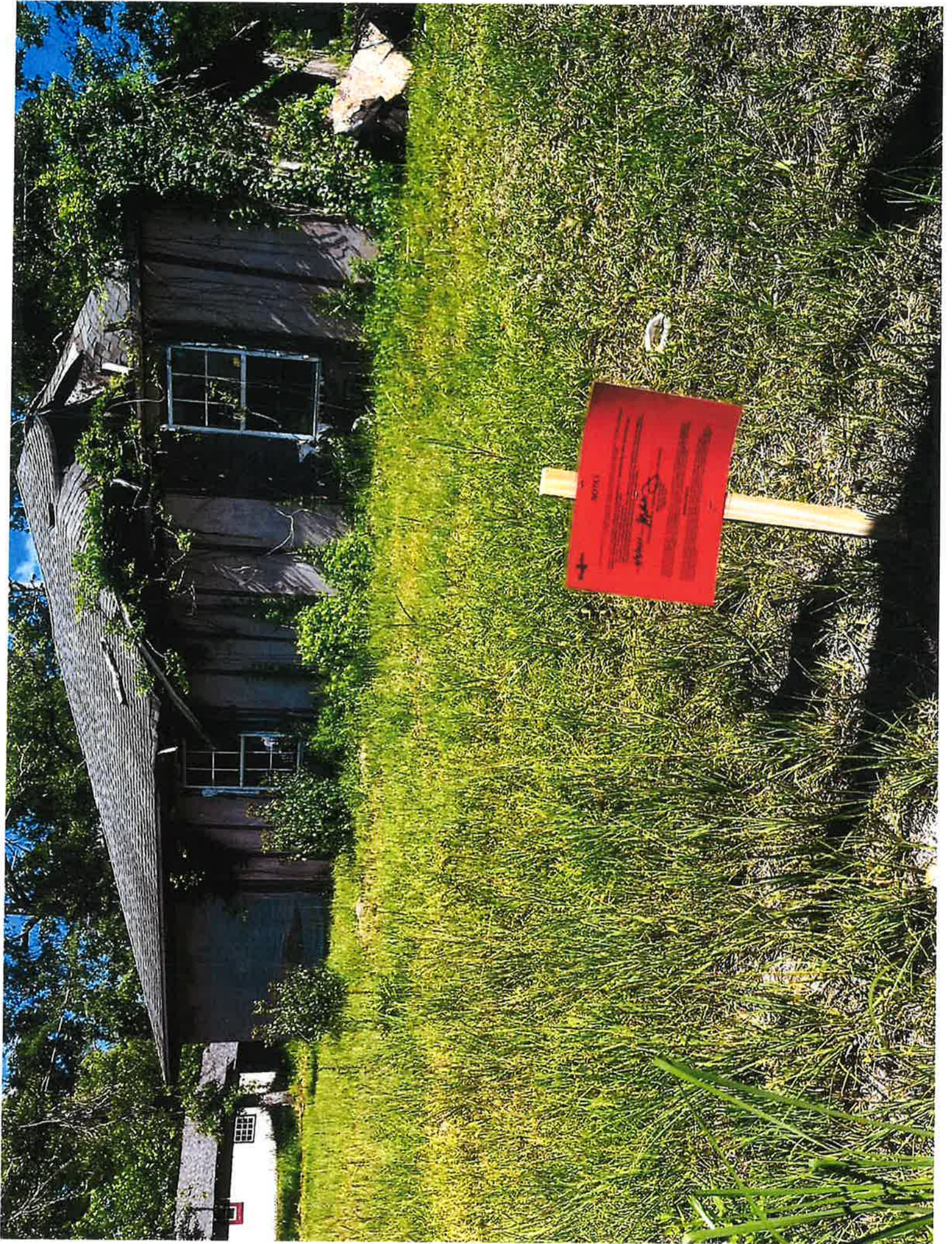

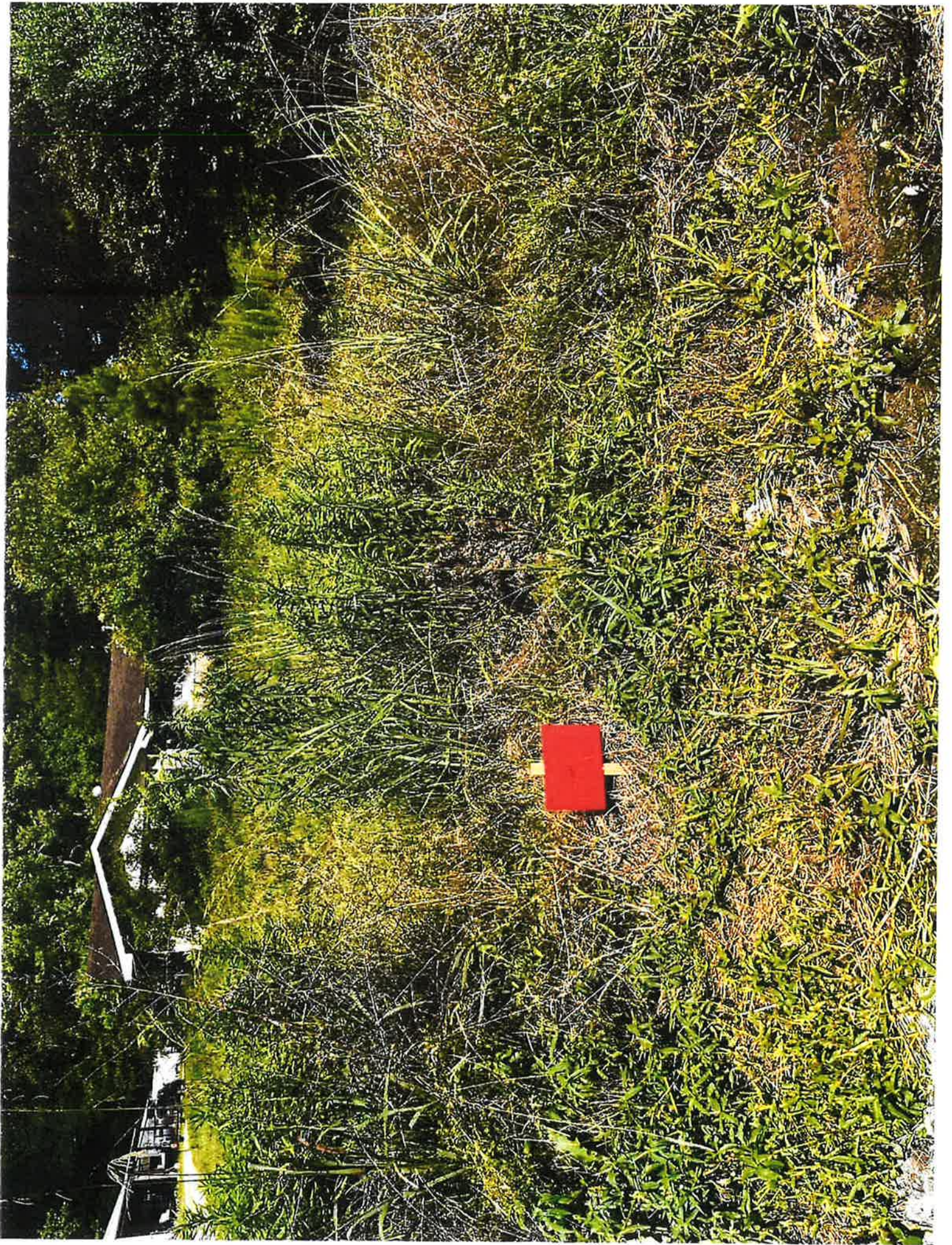

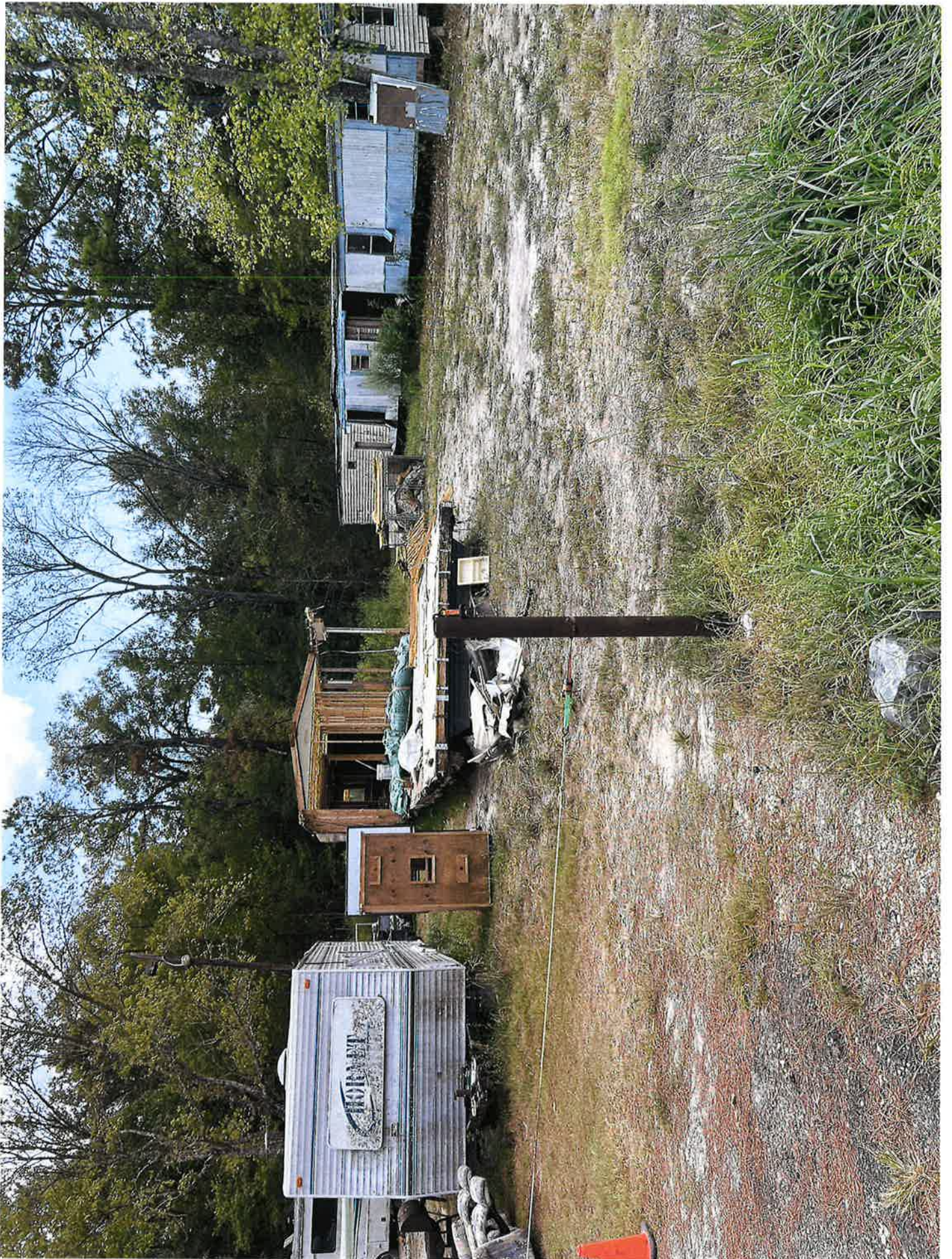

T. P. Ordinance No. 24-01

AN ORDINANCE TO AUTHORIZE THE TANGIPAHOA PARISH COUNCIL-PRESIDENT GOVERNMENT TO ACCEPT THE DONATION OF IMMOVABLE PROPERTIES AND ASSETS FROM EASTERN HEIGHTS WATER WORKS ASSOCIATION, INC. AND TO AUTHORIZE THE PARISH PRESIDENT OR HIS AUTHORIZED DESIGNEE TO SIGN ANY AND ALL DOCUMENTS IN REGARD TO THE ACCEPTANCE OF THE AFOREMENTIONED DONATION

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the citizens of Tangipahoa Parish that there is a safe and dependable water supply; and

WHEREAS, the private water company Eastern Heights Water Works Association, Inc. has had difficulty in maintaining the water system for customers of Eastern Heights Water Works Association, Inc. and needs assistance to keep operating; and
