Minutes - Monday, November 21, 2022 - 6:00 PM

Mayor Brown called the meeting to order at 6:00 PM.

PRESENT: Mayor Allen Brown, Ward 1 Director Terry Roberts, Ward 2 Director Laney Harris, Ward 4 Director Ulysses Brewer, Ward 5 Director Barbara Miner, and Ward 6 Director Jeff Hart.

Director Hart made the motion to adopt the Consent agenda, Seconded by Director Roberts. The motion carried and the following item was approved:

2. Resolution No. 2022-69 authorized the City Manager to enter into a contract with Stan Excavating Company for the demolition of the Regency House located at 110 E. Broad Street in Ward 2. (PWD) Public Works Director Tyler Richards
