RESOLVED, that the Town Board is hereby authorized to proceed with the project, ratifying the Town's prior Consolidates Funding Application to the DEC & New York State Climate Smart Award Program submitted on February 28, 2020, approving the imminent purchase of the H.O.R.S.E. Anaerobic Digester* from Impact Bioenergy for \$127,500.00 with monies to be reimbursed by the NYS DEC (Contract N. DEC01-C01014GG-3350000) and the Climate Smart Award (\$63,750.00 match) and ratifying the contract for professional services with the Center for EcoTechnology, Inc ** which was signed on March 29, 2020.
