The solar panels have been off for about three weeks and would like to be able to turn them on

Code Enforcement Officer stated that he can not give a CO to a non -compliant project. Non compliant items are vegetation, paving, mowing, sheep

The sheep will be put in the fence as soon as the grass is high enough and they are trying different types of grasses. Water will be from Roto Rooter for the sheep. At the next meeting more information will be available on when the sheep will be arriving.
