
Public comments. There were no public comments.

The first item on the agenda was the reading of the minutes from the meeting held February 26, 2018. Councilmember Terry Freese made a motion to approve the minutes. Councilmember Don Mueller seconded the motion. All voted in favor.

The second item on the agenda was to review and consider Sanitation and Decontamination Services for City Facilities, Properties and Vehicles. Community Development Director Gwyn Teves stated to the Committee that the City of Wharton received sealed bids for sanitation and decontamination services to be used in the event of an emergency on June 2, 2020 at 2:00 p.m. She stated that the proposals would have to be rated by the Committee and a recommendation formulated to be presented on the June 22, 2020 City Council meeting. After some discussion, no action was taken.
