

Dear Wharton Beautification Commission,

Hesed House of Wharton is partnering with local artist Melissa Garza and community volunteers to create a wildflower mural in Dinosaur Park. The mural will be located on the east facing wall of a city owned structure, making it visible from the Colorado River bridge. This garage structure was originally slated for demolition as part of the levee construction. Gwyn Teves has recently confirmed the structure will not be demolished and Hesed House has requested use of the building and permission to improve the exterior.

Hesed House has scheduled a mural painting day on May 18th and is requesting a grant to help with supplies. Your donation in any amount will be greatly appreciated and will contribute to a more vibrant park space even before levee construction is completed.
