Attached you will find a memo to me from Chief Terry Lynch regarding the Texas Department of Transportations resurfacing project for State Highway 60 starting in the Spring of 2020. The recommend changes are as follows:

- 1. Re-striping of State Highway 60 (Milam Street), westbound from North Resident Street to Business 59 (Richmond Road) to a one-way single-marked lane.
- 2. Eliminate the corner parking spaces at the following intersections:
 - A. State Highway 60 (Milam Street) at Houston Street.
 - B. State Highway 60 (Milam Street) at Polk Street.
 - C. Alley way entrance (200 West Milam Street) State Highway 60.
- 3. Protected arrows at State Highway 60 (Milam Street) and FM 1299 (North Alabama Road) for Northbound and Southbound traffic.
- 4. Increase the pause between red and green Indicators on the traffic control devices at the following intersections:
 - A. FM 1301 (West Boling Highway) at Business 59 (North Richmond Road).
 - B. FM 1301 (West Boling Highway) at North Fulton Street.
 - C. FM1301 (East Boling Highway) at North Alabama Road.
 - D. Business 59 (North Richmond Road) at FM 102.
 - E. Business 59 (North Richmond Road) at State Highway 60 (West Burleson Street).
 - F. State Highway 60 (Milam Street) at FM 1299 (North Alabama Road).

Ref: Recommendations TxDOT for 2020 Hwy 60 Project

In the Spring of 2020, TxDOT has scheduled a resurfacing project for State Hwy 60 that will affect the City of Wharton from the City Limits to the intersection of N. Richmond Road. I have visited with Downtown merchants and met with TxDOT Area Engineer Ryan Simper to discuss possible solutions to reported traffic safety issues that are occurring along that route, particularly in our downtown area. In our meeting, we discussed requesting the following changes that we believe will benefit the community along that route. They are as follows:

- 1. Re-stripe the State Hwy 60 (Milam St), westbound from N. Resident St to Bus. 59 (Richmond Rd) to a ONE-WAY SINGLE-MARKED LANE.
- 2. Eliminate the corner parking spaces at the following intersections:
 - a. State Hwy 60 (Milam St) @ Houston St
 - b. State Hwy 60 (Milam St) @ Polk St
 - c. Alley way entrance (200 W. Milam St) State Hwy 60
- 3. Protected arrows @ State Hwy 60 (Milam St) and FM1299 (N. Alabama Rd) for Northbound and Southbound traffic
- 4. Increase the PAUSE between Red and Green Indicators on the traffic control devices at the following intersections:
 - a. FM1301 (W. Boling Hwy) @ Business 59 (N. Richmond Rd)
 - b. FM1301 (W. Boling Hwy) @ N. Fulton St
 - c. FM1301 (E. Boling Hwy) @ N. Alabama Rd
 - d. Business 59 (N. Richmond Rd) @ FM102
 - e. Business 59 (N. Richmond Rd) @ State Hwy 60 (W. Burleson St)
 - f. State Hwy 60 (Milam St) @ FM1299 (N. Alabama Rd)

Subject to your approval, I am requesting that the changes be placed on the agenda for approval for the City Manager's Office to formally request these changes prior to the resurfacing project. I believe that these changes will have a direct positive impact on the safety of our motorists and pedestrians.

A RESOLUTION OF THE WHARTON CITY COUNCIL AUTHORIZING THE SUBMISSION OF A LETTER TO THE TEXAS DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION (TXDOT) REQUESTING IMPROVEMENTS TO STATE HIGHWAY 60 AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR OF THE CITY OF WHARTON TO EXECUTE ALL DOCUMENTS RELATED TO SAID SUBMISSION.

- WHEREAS, The City of Wharton finds it in the best interest of the citizens of City of Wharton to submit a request to the Texas Department of Transportation for improvements to State Highway 60; and,
- **WHEREAS,** In the Spring of 2020, the Texas Department of Transportation has scheduled a resurfacing project for State Highway 60 that will affect the City of Wharton from the City Limits; and,
- **WHEREAS,** The City Staff wishes to submit the following changes to the Texas Department of Transportation:
 - 1. Re-striping of State Highway 60 (Milam Street), westbound from North Resident Street to Business 59 (Richmond Road) to a one-way single-marked lane.
 - 2. Eliminate the corner parking spaces at the following intersections:
 - A. State Highway 60 (Milam Street) at Houston Street.
 - B. State Highway 60 (Milam Street) at Polk Street.
 - C. Alley way entrance (200 West Milam Street) State Highway 60.
 - 3. Protected arrows at State Highway 60 (Milam Street) and FM 1299 (North Alabama Road) for Northbound and Southbound traffic.
 - 4. Increase the pause between red and green Indicators on the traffic control devices at the following intersections:
 - A. FM 1301 (West Boling Highway) at Business 59 (North Richmond Road).
 - B. FM 1301 (West Boling Highway) at North Fulton Street.
 - C. FM1301 (East Boling Highway) at North Alabama Road.
 - D. Business 59 (North Richmond Road) at FM 102.
 - E. Business 59 (North Richmond Road) at State Highway 60 (West Burleson Street).
 - F. State Highway 60 (Milam Street) at FM 1299 (North Alabama Road).

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WHARTON, TEXAS as follows:

- **Section I.** That the Wharton City Council hereby approves the submission of a letter to the Texas Department of Transportation for the above mentioned.
- **Section II.** That the Wharton City Council authorizes the Mayor of the City of Wharton to execute

all documents relating to said letter submission.
