Mr. Garza,

Public works has been working on our portion of the 2020 Street Program with street sweeping, shoulder edging, tree trimming, patching or repair work as needed for contractor portion of the total sealcoat later this year. Attached is our current progress.

I have been communicating with Bradley Loehr and Chad Emmel with BEFCO Engineering. Attached please find their Engineering Contract, draft specification for our review, Proposed schedule, and sample roadway exhibit.

These are Chad's notes:

• Proposed project schedule for your review and consideration. Note that although I indicate a 75day construction contract period on the schedule we are considering making it a deadline contract of October 16th instead;

• Sample Roadway Exhibit – This is the type of exhibit we intend to prepare for every street within the project. We will also prepare an index sheet which will identify all the streets and their respective assigned street number (exhibit number).

• Draft specifications – With your blessing, we intend to bid the project out as a single line item contract based on our estimated square yardage of proposed seal coat. We are debating internally if we should provide a mobilization item. Sweeping & vacuuming post application will be subsidiary to the project.

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PROJECT SPECIFICATIONS

The following specifications are proposed for the base bid items for this construction project. Texas Department of Transportation Standard Specifications for Construction of Highway, Streets and Bridges, 2014.

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Reference Items

Item 9 Measurement & Payment Item 100 Preparing R-O-W Item 210 Rolling Item 300 Asphalts, Oils and Emulsions Item 302 Aggregates for Surface Treatments Item 316 Surface Treatments Item 502 Barricades, Signs and Traffic Handling Item 738 Cleaning & Sweeping Highways

The above-listed specification items are those under which payment is to be made. These, together with such other pertinent items, if any, as may be referred to in the above-listed specification items shown above, constitute the complete specifications for this project.

SURPLUS SPECIFICATION NOTES

ITEM 9 MEASUREMENT AND PAYMENT (SUBSIDIARY)

All materials purchased for the bid items shall be accompanied by load tickets and given to the INSPECTOR and/or ENGINEER on a minimum weekly basis. Each month the CONTRACTOR shall provide documentation that provides an accounting of all materials with each pay request for all bid items that are quantity based such as tons of material, gallons of asphalt, etc. There is no separate payment for this item and is subsidiary to the various other bid items.

ITEM 100 PREPARING R-O-W (SUBSIDIARY)

This item is listed to inform CONTRACTOR that they are responsible for all protection of existing street structures, trees, landscaping, fences, etc. not listed under construction of this project. Do not park equipment, service equipment, store materials, disturb the root areas, etc. under branches of trees & other vegetation designated for preservation. There is no separate payment for this item and is subsidiary to the various other bid items.

The Contractor will be required to place paper to square off intersection asphalt surfacing work where matching to existing street areas and at areas designated by the Engineer. This includes water valves, manholes, concrete streets/driveways, concrete drainage structures, concrete curbing, etc.

ITEM 316 SURFACE TREATMENTS

Project consists of a single course of asphalt and aggregate. The proposed asphalt rates are an average. The rates will vary depending on the condition of the street surface. Please note that asphalt in some areas such as street radii, curves, cul-de-sacs, parking lots, etc. may have to be applied by hand. Applied aggregate shall be rolled with one pass of a medium-weight pneumatic flat wheel roller.

A single finish course shall only be required for sealing existing paved streets.

The Contractor will be required to provide barricades, cones and flagmen to handle traffic through and around the construction area.

The Contractor will be required to place paper to square off intersection asphalt surfacing work where matching to existing street areas and at areas designated by the Engineer. This includes water valves, manholes, concrete streets/driveways, concrete drainage structures, concrete curbing, etc.

Item to be paid on a square yardage completed basis utilizing the application rates provided.

Asphalt: AC-15P @ 0.32 Gal/yd² Aggregate: Gr 4 Trap Rock @ 110 yd²/yd³

ITEM 738 CLEANING AND SWEEPING (SUBSIDIARY)

Following paving activities, the CONTRACTOR shall sweep and vacuum the completed streets approximately five (5) days after being seal coated. Excess or piled aggregate may be lightly broomed the same day, if necessary, to evenly spread out rock. Final sweep and vacuuming shall be done in the early morning hours while aggregate will be held more firmly in place. Care shall be taken to avoid sweeping loose material into adjacent grassy areas. If sweeping equipment is utilized it shall be limited to sweeping the center line of the street toward the curb or from the curb line toward the center of roadway. Vacuum equipment shall be utilized along the gutter line to pick up excess rock or other debris and delivered to a city approved location. In the event rock or other construction debris is swept onto the adjacent grass the Contractor shall immediately, at their sole expense, thoroughly clean the area to the satisfaction of the City.
