- A. Advocacy (Debbie Folks)
 - a. The rules for the dog park approved on December 13, 2023, were approved by Paul Webb, the city attorney, with a few minor changes.

- b. Debbie Folks presented to the commission an updated quote by Custom Creations. The printing of the signs will still be \$295, to install the signs by Custom Creations will be \$346.66. Debbie Folks made the motion to send the rules and installation information to the Parks and Recreation Committee for approval, seconded by Nancy Mata, all in favor

- C. Community (Adraylle Watson)
 - 1. Grant giving for projects & community requests for supplies/volunteers: No action taken.
 - 2. Event/Merchandise booths: No action taken.
 - 3. Train Depot Signs: Debbie Folks inquired about paint from Sherwin-Williams. The paint suggested would be \$29.15/gallon and should be able to be used on all of the posts, Sherwin-Williams will also supply smaller paint cans to pour the paint into. Debbie has contacted the Wharton Noon Day Lions to volunteer. Rachel Roberson motioned to approve the purchase of the paint, seconded by Sheryl Joost. All in favor. The City Liaison and Debbie Folks will coordinate on purchasing the paint.
- D. Education (Adraylle Watson/Rachel Roberson)
 - 1. Social media campaigns: No Action.
- E. Garden (Rachel Roberson)
 - 1. Planter Adoption program: Girl Scouts did not renew. Wharton High School Anchor Club has been working hard on the Museum flower bed and has even placed a tiger made out of reused tires.
 - 2. Painted Rock Garden: Rachel Roberson and the City Liaison will coordinate a time to make the purchases of the remainder bags.
 - 3. Santa Fe Planters: Alamo Lumber has donated landscaping timbers, and will hold to on to them till a date is set. The committee will begin to look at possible dates for the project.

 - 1. GFL has confirmed that April 20, 2024 will work. The City Liaison suggested someone can look into programs that recycle tires to help offset the cost, Adrylle Watson said he would look into it.
