CITY COUNCIL PARKS AND RECREATION COMMITTEE MEETING

City Hall, 120 East Caney Street, Wharton, Texas Monday, May 8, 2023 6:00 p.m.

Assistant City Manager, Paula Favors, declared a meeting of the City Council Parks and Recreation Committee duly open for the transaction of business at 6:01 p.m.

Committee Members present: Councilmember, Steven Schneider; Councilmember,

Russell Machann, and Councilmember, Terry

Freese.

Committee Member absent: None.

Council Member present: None.

Staff Members present: Assistant City Manager, Paula Favors; Assistant to

the City Manager, Brandi Jimenez; Finance Director, Joan Andel; Building Official, Claudia Velasquez, and Public Works Director, Anthony Arcidiacono.

Staff Members absent: City Manager, Joseph R. Pace.

Visitors present: Ms. Debbie Folks and Mr. Adraylle Watson.

Public comments. There were no public comments.

The first item on the agenda was to review and consider minutes from the meeting held on March 13, 2023. Councilmember, Russell Machann, made a motion to approve the minutes as presented. Councilmember, Steve Schneider, seconded. All voted in favor.

The second item on the agenda was to review and consider the City of Wharton Dog Park:

- A. Resolution: A resolution of the Wharton City Council approving a location for the City of Wharton Dog Park and authorizing the Mayor of the City of Wharton to execute all documents related to said approval.
- B. Resolution: A resolution of the Wharton City Council awarding a contract to Kraftsman Commercial Playgrounds & Water Parks for the installation of fencing and equipment for the Dog Park and authorizing the Mayor of the City of Wharton to execute all documents related to said contract. Building Official, Claudia Velasquez, stated to the Committee that the Beautification Commission was recommending to the City Council the installation of a Dog Park on the Santa Fe Trail located at 900 North Fulton Street. She stated that with the efforts and assistance from the Public Works Department, Facility Maintenance Department, and Building Department a visual walkthrough was conducted.

She stated that the City Staff believed that the Dog Park would benefit the citizens if it was to be built on the Santa Fe Trail for the following reasons:

- Existing access to lighting from Santa Fe Trail.
- Adequate parking spaces.
- Access to waterlines for the dog drinking fountains.
- Adequate shading from the gazebo and planted trees.

She also presented two alternate locations for the Dog Park.

She stated that also, on January 10, 2022, the City Council approved to implement and fundraise for a Dog Park in an existing City Park. She stated that with fundraising efforts and assistance from Bay Area Council on Drugs & Alcohol (BACODA) that the Dog Park would be fully funded to build the Dog Park. She stated that the following proposal was obtained from Kraftsman Commercial Playgrounds & Water Parks in the amount of \$56,793.38. She stated that Kraftsman Commercial Playgrounds & Water Parks was a member of the BuyBoard Cooperative Program. After some discussion, Councilmember, Terry Freese, made a motion to recommend to the City Council to build the Dog Park at 900 North Fulton Street for the Dog Park. Councilmember, Steven Schneider, seconded the motion. All voted in favor. Councilmember, Terry Freese, made a motion to recommend to the City Council to award a contract to Kraftsman Commercial Playgrounds & Water Parks for the installation of the fencing and equipment for the Dog Park. Councilmember, Russell Machann, seconded the motion. All voted in favor.

The third item on the agenda was to review and consider a Resolution: A resolution of the Wharton City Council accepting funding from the Bay Area Council on Drugs & Alcohol (BACODA) for the Beautification Commission's Rock Garden Project and authorizing the Mayor to execute all documents related to said funding. Building Official, Claudia Velasquez, stated to the Committee that on January 18, 2023, the Bay Area Council on Drugs & Alcohol (BACODA) announced to fully fund the Beautification Commission's Rock Garden Project at the Wharton County Library in the amount of \$2,000.00. She stated that the Beautification Commission and the City Liaison received notification that the Project had been selected for award and funding. She stated that the Rock Garden Project was presented to the Wharton County Commissioner's Court and received approval. After some discussion, Councilmember, Russell Machann, made a motion to recommend to the City Council to accept the funding from the Bay Area Council on Drugs & Alcohol (BACODA) for the Beautification Commission's Rock Garden Project. Councilmember, Terry Freese, seconded the motion. All voted in favor.
