Chairperson, Adraylle Watson declared a Regular Meeting of the Beautification Commission held at City Hall, 120 East Caney Street, Wharton, Texas 77488 duly open for the transaction of business at 4:30 p.m.

Motion to excuse absences by Debbie Folks, seconded by Ken Dimmick, all in favor.

#### The first item on the agenda to review & consider: Election of Officers.

Nomination of Chairperson to be Adraylle Watson was made by Ken Dimmick and seconded by Debbie Folks, all in favor.

Nomination of Vice-Chairperson to be Ken Dimmick was made by Debbie Folks and seconded by Nancy Mata, all in favor.

Nomination of Secretary to be Nancy Mata made by Ken Dimmick and seconded by Debbie Folks, all in favor.

The second item on the agenda was to review and consider: Reading of the minutes for the Regular Meeting held on held May 11, 2022.

#### The fifth item on the agenda was to review and consider: 2022 Planning.

- A. Advocacy (Debbie Folks)
  - 1. Fundraising-Dog Park: Commission discussed working with the Wharton EDC for virtual fundraising through their organization. Request was made to have the approximate location of the dog park staked out by the facilities maintenance department for a visual inspection and looking into getting a sign stating "future home of dog park" purchased and installed. The commission was advised of advertising opportunity and costs provided by the Wharton Journal Spectator for website advertising to promote the dog park fundraiser. It was decided to not pursue this due to costs. Commission decided to explore the dog-themed t-shirt idea with further discussion. There were no actions taken.
  - 2. Fire hydrant survey: Commission requested information on what could be done to get the fire hydrants painted. They had been advised that they could not do the work through volunteers but were aware of the Caney Creek Conservation Foundation doing some painting. This will be investigated further. Debbie Folks requested to receive the photos that have been submitted to date.
- B. Art (Stephanie Konvicka)
  - 1. Park mini-mural: No discussion.
- C. Community (Adraylle Watson)
  - 1. Grant giving for projects & community requests for supplies/volunteers: No requests at this time.
  - 2. Event/Merchandise booths: Commission discussed future events to participate in, including Farmers Market, Wine Fair and Snow Day on the Square.
  - 3. Train Depot Signs: Ken Dimmick advised that their was an interested Scout that wanted to take on the project and that they would present to the Commission at a later date for the funding and council approval. Ken Dimmick also provided a visual aid by showing one of the signs that had fallen from the pole.
- D. Education (Adraylle Watson)
  - 1. Social media campaigns Recycle Tip Tuesday, ordinances: Commission

- E. Garden (Rachel Roberson)
  - 1. Planter Adoption program: Commission discussed posting the new available planters for adoption on the Facebook page. Commission also discussed the current status of the existing planters and who had renewed adoptions and what planters are available.
